BONNERS FERRY JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twenty-fourth** day of **July** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-eight** and is duly recorded on Film No. **103** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Bonnors Ferry** in the County of **Boundary** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BONNERS FERRY JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.

organized

UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF IDAHO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, all of whom are residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming and incorporating a non-profit, benevolent, charitable, and fraternal organization under and by virtue of the provisions of IDAHO CODE, Page 11, Title 30, as amended, and hereby make, subscribe and execute the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I.

The name assumed by this corporation and by which it shall be known is: BONNERS FERRY JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be Bonners Ferry, County of Boundary, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III.

The time for which the said corporation shall be created shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

This corporation is a non-profit organization, and is formed for the following benevolent, charitable and social purposes and objects:

1. To provide the younger business and professional men of the City of Bonners Ferry, a medium for training in citizenship and chamber of commerce work; to promote and render constructive civic service for the promotion of the welfare of the community and of the citizens of Boundary County, to inculcate civic consciousness by means of active participation in constructive projects which will improve the community, state, and nation; to secure and disseminate accurate information relating thereto; to oppose legislation unfavorable thereto; and to support and promote legislation favorable thereto.
2. To cooperate with the Bonners Ferry Chamber of Commerce, Inc., in advancing its program of usefulness to the City, State and Nation.
3. To purchase or otherwise acquire and to hold, own and exercise all rights, of ownership in real estate and personal property and to sell, transfer or mortgage said real estate and

personal property; to borrow money; to erect buildings or other structures necessary and proper for the carrying out of the purposes herein mentioned; to enter into all contracts necessary in conducting its affairs; to render such benevolent aid and assistance to its members as provided by its By-Laws; and to receive donations and manage, take and hold real and personal property by gift, grant, devise, or bequest.

ARTICLE V.

This corporation does not have and shall not have any capital stock, neither shall it issue to its members certificates representing capital stock, and this corporation shall not be operated for a pecuniary profit.

ARTICLE VI.

The number of directors of this corporation shall be seven (7) in number and the term of office, qualifications of Directors and manner of election shall be provided for in the By-Laws. The names and addresses of those who are to serve as incorporating Directors and until the election and qualification of the successors are as follows:

ARTICLE VII.

Pursuant to notice published in the Bonners Ferry Herald, a newspaper published in Bonners Ferry, Idaho, on June 26 and July 3, 1958, a meeting of the members of the Bonners Ferry Junior Chamber of Commerce, was held on Thursday, the 10th day of July, 1958 at the hour of 7:00 o'clock P.M., at which time and place a majority of the members of this association were present and voted at the election held at said meeting, and the persons above named were duly elected as the incorporating Directors for the first year of this corporation and until the election and qualification of their successors, as required in IDAHO CODE 30-1102.

ARTICLE VIII.

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in any respect at any regular or special meeting of members called for that purpose. An amendment must first be approved by two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors and then adopted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members present and voting at said meeting: provided, that a quorum, as specified by the By-Laws of said

corporation be present. Notice of any proposed amendment shall, after approval of two-thirds of the Board of Directors, be given to the members in the manner provided by Section 30-1103 of the IDAHO CODE.
