

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.
OF

"The CURRENT-JOURNAL PUBLISHING CO."

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Know all men by these presents:-

That we, the undersigned have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the Laws of the State of Idaho;

FIRST, That the name of said corporation is "The Current-Journal Publishing Co."

SECOND, That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are to carry on and conduct a general newspaper, publishing and job printing business, to print and publish newspapers and such other periodicals as from time to time may be desired; and also to buy, sell and deal in books, stationery, paper, paper bags, typewriters, office and school supplies; and also to buy and sell such real and personal property as may be necessary to successfully and conveniently conduct said business, or with ^{which} to secure or erect such buildings as are reasonably necessary or incidental to said business.

THIRD, That the place where its principal business shall be conducted and transacted is Rexburg, Fremont county, Idaho.

Fourth, That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

FIFTH, That the number of its directors shall be five, and that the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first term are:

SIXTH, That the amount of the Capital Stock of this corporation shall be and is Six Thousand Dollars, divided into sixty shares of the par value of One Hundred Dollars each. Twenty shares of Two

Thousand Dollars of said stock to be issued, held, known and denoted as preferred stock, and forty shares of Four Thousand Dollars of said stock to be issued, held, known and denoted as common stock. The certificate of said stock when issued must have written or printed upon them the above paragraph of this article and shall denote and have written or printed thereon the class to which each respective certificate belongs, whether Preferred or Common, and also the following paragraph relative to the disbursement of dividends. All dividends shall be disbursed as follows:- The preferred stock shall draw dividends at the rate of one and one half per cent per month payable on the 10th day of each succeeding month commencing April 10th, 1905, to the exclusion of the common stock, and before it shall draw any dividends whatever. All dividends above the amount paid upon the preferred stock shall be drawn and paid upon the common stock to the exclusion of the preferred stock, in the same manner and at the same time. The holders of both Common and Preferred stock shall participate equally in the management and control of the corporation and its business.

SEVENTH, The Capital stock of this corporation shall be non assessable and the private property of the stockholders shall not be liable for the debts of the corporation.

EIGHTH. That the amount of said capital stock which has been actually subscribed is Two Thousand Dollars of Preferred stock and Four Thousand Dollars of Common Stock, and the following are the names of the persons by whom the same has been subscribed:
