#### AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

#### YANKEE MINES, INCORPORATED

The Undersigned President and Secretary of Yankee Mines, Incorporated, a corporation, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, hereby certify that at a special meeting of the shareholders of said corporation held on the 29th day of April, 1950, at Boise, Ada County, Idaho, after thirty days written notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting had been given by personal service and by mail to said shareholders, a resolution was adopted by the affirmative vote of more than two-thirds of the total number of shares of capital stock outstanding, as follows:

"BE IT RESOLVED: That the number of Directors of Yankee Mines, Incorporated, be increased from five (5) directors to nine (9) directors by amending Article V of the Articles of Incorporation of said Corporation to read as follows:

## " ARTICLE V

"'The business of this corporation shall be managed and conducted by a Board of nine (9) Directors and it shall not be necessary that a Director be a stockholder of the corporation'.

"AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Officers of this corporation be, and they are hereby, authorized to take any and all necessary steps to make this Amendment effective."
