
### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION OF

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF

PARENTS EDUCATING PARENTS, INC

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the United States, associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit, social and benevolent corporation under the provisions of Chapter III, Title 30, Idaho Code, amendatory and supplemental thereto, and we do certify and declare as follows:

ARTICLE I.

That the name of the corporation shall be PARENTS EDUCATING PARENTS, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The objectives of this corporation are:

1. To improve and promote the general welfare of all persons in this area who are parents and their children.
2. To educate parents on how to teach their children in positive ways, to help educate them in proper and adequate discipline techniques and to provide opportunities for such parents to learn based on proven methods of teaching children how to follow their consistent and concise directions the first time and to increase the self-image of parents and to reduce the neglect and abuse of children.
3. To offer opportunities for parents to role play how to employ creative solutions when there is a conflict in the family

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1 and to assist parents in educating their children mentally,  
2 socially, and physically.

3 4. To offer education in breast feeding and encourage breast  
4 feeding of babies to provide for stronger and healthier babies, but  
5 also to provide the help and education to those mothers who also  
6 choose not to breast feed.

7 5. To encourage and help provide incentives for timely  
8 immunizations of children, particularly before their production  
9 into Kindergarten.

10 6. To provide through the use of para-professionals and  
11 volunteers the need for responsibility of setting and prioritizing  
12 goals with individual families and empowering them to take  
13 responsibility upon themselves through education, to assist in  
14 teaching the parenting skills on an individual basis to such  
15 parents or in a group session, whichever is most convenient, and  
16 through such services to provide a community linkage that will help  
17 mothers and fathers of Idaho County to become responsible, capable  
18 and competent parents.

19 7. To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, convey,  
20 mortgage and/or lease, real and personal property; to dispose of,  
21 sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage and/or convey any rights,  
22 privileges, franchises, real or personal property of the  
23 corporation, other than its franchise of being a corporation; and  
24 to acquire, purchase, guaranty, hold, mortgage, own vote, sell,  
25 pledge and/or otherwise dispose of and deal in shares, bonds,  
26 securities and debentures and other evidence of indebtedness or  
27 other corporations, domestic or foreign.

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**ARTICLE III.**

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

**ARTICLE IV.**

That the principal place of business of this corporation shall be at 709 W. North Street, City of Grangeville, State of Idaho.

**ARTICLE V.**

That the fiscal year of this corporation shall be from the date of its inception to the conclusion of that year and thereafter annually from January 1 to December 31.

**ARTICLE VI.**

Membership, qualifications and payment of dues, if any, shall be determined by, and in the discretion of the said Board of Directors of this Corporation, subject, however, to the provisions of these articles.

**ARTICLE VII.**

No member shall be liable for, nor shall any of their property be subject to, any debt or obligation of the corporation.

**ARTICLE VIII.**

The corporation shall have no capital stock, and the rights and interests of such members shall be equal with no one having the right to acquire greater interest of the others.

**ARTICLE IX.**

Upon dissolution of this corporation, after payment of all debts, obligations and liabilities of the corporation or the making of adequate provision therefore, the remaining property and assets shall be distributed back to the foundation originally granting the money for the development of this organization or, in the

1 alternative, at the discretion of the Board of Directors, to be  
2 used for the benevolent purposes as set forth in these articles.

3 **ARTICLE X.**

4 That the directors of this corporation shall be such number of  
5 persons, not less than three (3), nor more than ten (10), as may  
6 be, from time to time, prescribed by the by-laws, and until the  
7 first meeting and organization of the corporation, the following  
8 persons shall serve as directors of said corporation, to-wit:

22 annual election of directors which shall be provided for in the By-
