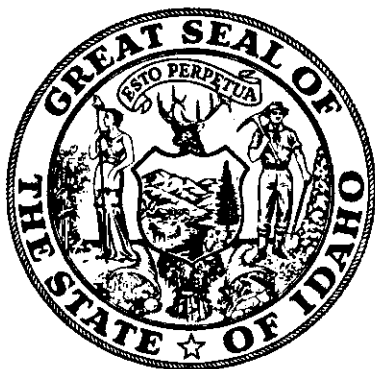

Dear Mr. Zauha,

The Southfield Irrigation Company held a special meeting on March 12, 1980 at Paris, Idaho. More than a majority of the shares were represented, 195 out of 225 outstanding. A motion was made by Richard Stocker to have our corporation reinstated and to amend Article IV in our *articles* to read "perpetual" instead of the fifty years now stated. This was seconded by Ernest Nye and the vote was unanimous in favor.

The amendment will read "That the term for which it is to exist is perpetual".
