# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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OF

# VAMWAYS MOVING AND STORAGE, INC.

undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the general corporation laws of the State of Idaho and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, do hereby certify as follows:

## ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be VANWAYS MOVING AND STORAGE, INC.

#### ARTICLE II.

The principal place of business is 346 Steelhead Way, Boise, Idaho \$3709, and the registered agent is Ronald D. Pack, at such address.

#### ARTICLE III.

The objects and purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

As principal, agent or otherwise to do, in any part of ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION - 1

the world, any and all of the things herein set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do. In furtherance, and not in limitation, of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho, we do expressly provide that the corporation shall have power:

- A. To move, store, pack and crate, any and all items of personal property and generally, to conduct a moving and storage business.
- B. To engage in, contract and carry on in all its various branches the business of transportation for itself, or for others for hire, of goods, wares, furniture and merchandise of every kind and character by means of motor trucks and trailers.
- C. To engage in, contract and carry on in all its various branches, its business of intrastate and interstate hauling, transport in carrying personal property consisting of goods, wares, furniture, and merchandise of every kind and character, and to operate, own and utilise all state and federal trucking licenses and permits in the operation in the moving and storing business.
- D. To engage in every type of lawful business, industry or commercial activity, including, without limitation, the activities set forth in paragraph A above.

- pledge, sell, transfer, encumber and in any other manner to dispose of, deal and trade in goods, wares, merchandise and personal property of every class and description, whether at wholesale, retail or otherwise.
- 7. To loan money upon notes, bonds, stocks or any other evidence of indebtedness.
- assist in the establishment, organisation or formation of other companies, firms, or corporations having for their objects, or some of them, any of the objects mentioned in these Articles, or the development and furtherance of any other undertaking or business enterprise of any description whatsoever, and to purchase, own and hold stock in other corporations and interest in other business enterprises, and to sell the same, and to receive compensation for any services rendered in connection with any of the foregoing matters.

To borrow money for the business of the company and to give security therefor and, in pursuance of the business of the company, to issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes or other evidences of indebtedness, and to secure the same by mortgage or pledge of all or any of the property of the company, real or

## personal.

I. To do generally any and all things which the company may deem necessary, proper and convenient in its said business for the improvement and use of the corporation property and in carrying out and accomplishing the purposes hereinbefore specified, and in addition thereto to have all the general powers granted to corporations by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho and of any other state in which the corporation may do business.

## ARTICLE IV.

The total authorised capital stock of the corporation shall be One Hundred (100) shares of common stock of the par value of \$100.00 per share, with each share being entitled to one vote and not subject to assessment.

#### ARTICLE V.

The term of existence of the corporation shall be in perpetuity.

#### ARTICLE VI.

The number of the directors of this corporation at the commencement of business shall be two (2), but the Board of Directors may at any time, by amendment of the By-Laws, be increased to any number not exceeding fifteen (15).
