That they were the Chairman and Secretary, respectively, of a special meeting of the stockholders of Columbia Paint Co., a Montana corporation, held on the 20th day of October, 1964, for the purpose of amending the Articles of Incorporation of the company, and that the following is a true and correct copy of all of the proceedings had and done at said meeting:

The capital stock of said Corporation shall be one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) divided into fifteen thousand (15,000) shares of the par value of ten dollars (\$10.00) each.'

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was seconded by Stockholder W. H. Porter and upon being out to a vote, was carried by the unanimous vote of all of the stockholders present in person or by proxy, voting interson or by proxy all of the issued and outstanding capital stock of the corporation, to-wit: Ayes: 5,814 shares; Noes: None; Absent and Not Voting: None.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the same was upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned at 10:45 o'clock A.M. on October 20, 1964.
