ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of 18 years or more, acting as incorporators for the purpose of creating a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, as contained in Title 30, Chapter 301 et sec of the Idaho Code of the State of Idaho, entitled "Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act", and the several amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:

- 1. Name. The name of the Corporation is the MALAD AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.
- 2. Duration. The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.
- 3. Purposes. The purposes of this corporation are to advance the agricultural, small business, professional, commercial, industrial, civic and general interests of the City of Malad and its surrounding area. To advance the general prosperity of the area by development of the resources, roads, industries, tourism, and to encourage new capital and investments. To invite the interests of all the people to unite in an effort to obtain the needed reform and improvements that are beneficial to mankind for the general uplift of business, betterment of health and morals of the people in general. To take active interest in the beautification of homes, streets and civic pride in general.

- 9. Powers. The Corporation shall have all the powers granted corporations under the laws of the State of Idaho.

 However, notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the Corporation shall exercise only such powers as are in furtherance of the exempt purposes of organizations set forth in the subsection of section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 under which the Corporation chooses to qualify for exemption, as the same now exists, or as it may be amended from time to time.
- 10. Distribution of Dissolution. In the event of the dissolution of the Association, no member shall be entitled to any distribution or division of its remaining property or its proceeds, and the balance of all money and other property received by the Association from any source, after the payment of all debts and obligations of the Association, shall be used or distributed exclusively for purposes within the intendment of Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code as the same now exists or as it may be amended from time to time.
