

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

I.

23 The name of the corporation is: KELLOGG/DISTRICT 2
VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, INC.

2 II.

3 Kellogg/District 2 Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. is a
nonprofit corporation.

III.

4 The period of its duration is perpetual.

5

IV.

6 The purpose of the corporation is to provide the
citizens of Kellogg, Idaho, and Shoshone County Fire
Protection District 2 with a volunteer fire department to
supplement the professional fire-fighting staff of the City
of Kellogg and District 2. No part of the net earnings of
the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be dis-
tributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other
private persons, except that the corporation shall be
authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for
services rendered and to make payments and distributions in
furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. No substantial
part of the activities of the corporation shall be for the

carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

V.

The corporation shall consist of one class of members, the manner of selection, qualification, and rights of which are set forth in the corporate by-laws.

VI.

No assessment shall ever be levied upon the members of the corporation.

VII.

The address of the corporation's initial registered office is 323 Main Street, Kellogg, Idaho 83837.

The name of the corporation's initial registered agent at such address is BARBARA F. RINALDI.
