is duly recorded on Film No. **114** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State

tive Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MIDVALE SWIMMING POOL INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned all natural citizens of the United States and of full age Alvin Luke, Tom Holmes, John Keithley, Wilfred^{I.} Fox, and John^{E.} Bitner do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit, under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

The corporate name of this corporation shall be Midvale Swimming Pool Inc.

ARTICLE II.

A. To provide and furnish facilities to those persons who are interested in swimming and the teaching of swimming and water safety.

B. To operate and maintain the facilities and equipment and to hire the necessary employees and other personnel necessary to the operation and maintenance of a swimming pool.

C. To acquire, buy, own, hold, sell, exchange, let or lease personal property and real property within the State of Idaho, or outside the State of Idaho.

D. To borrow money for the purpose of this corporation, to issue notes and other evidence of indebtedness therefore, and to secure the same by mortgages or pledge of personal property, or by mortgage of real property. All or any portion of the real or personal property of the corporation may be so pledged, mortgaged or hypothecated.

E. To exercise generally the powers customarily exercised by non-profit cooperative associations, and particularly the powers provided by the laws of the State of Idaho, referring especially to Chapter Ten, Title Thirty, Idaho Code.

F. To carry on any other business, or to do anything in connection with the objects and purposes above mentioned that may be necessary or proper to accomplish successfully or promote the said objects and purposes of the corporation.

The foregoing clauses, by reason of the specific enumeration of powers, shall not be held to restrict the power of the corporation to do any of the things within the purview of its purposes.

ARTICLE III.

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV.

The location post office address and principal place shall be Midvale, Washington County, Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

The corporation shall be non stock and no dividend or pecuniary profits shall be declared or paid to the members thereof.

ARTICLE VI.

The corporation shall execute membership certificates to each member thereof, which certificates shall not be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the association, except by resolution of the Board of Directors. Membership qualifications, fees, and annual dues shall be as prescribed by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII.

The general officers of the corporation shall be a President, Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer. The number of Directors shall not be less than three nor more than fifteen. The number of Directors from time to time and the duties of the general officers of the corporation and of the Board of Directors shall be prescribed by the By-Laws. Further the mode of election of the general officers and of the Board of Directors shall be prescribed by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII.

These articles may be amended in the manner provided by the statute at the time of amendment.

ARTICLE IX.

The names and residences of the persons forming this corporation are Alvin Luke, Midvale, Idaho; Tom Holmes, Midvale, Idaho; John Keithley, Midvale, Idaho; Wilfred^{L.} Fox, Midvale, Idaho; and John^{E.} Pitner Midvale, Idaho.
