Articles of Incorporation of

The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, do hereby certify:

First: The name of the Corporation shall be The Alano Club of Nampa, Inc. The Alano Club of Nampa shall be a non-profit corporation. This corporation shall exist in perpetuity.

Second: The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is the City of Nampa, Canyon County.

Third: The purpose of this corporation shall be to promote social and fraternal activities in an alcohol/drug free atmosphere that are consistent with the philosophy and wishes of the membership, the corporate laws of Idaho, Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code.

Fourth: The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial trustees.

Fifth: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate

for public office. Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Gode, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Sixth: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 5'1(c'(3' of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Fleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Seventh: No person shall be denied membership based on sex, race, creed, age, ethnic origin or religious afiliation.

Eighth: The original registered office shall be 412-3rd St. So. Nampa, Id. 83651. The name of the original registered agent is Nellie I. Labrum.
