

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
of the  
WHITE CRYSTAL LIME COMPANY,  
Limited.

WHEREAS Oscar Eden, Frank Nelson, J.G. Julien, Nelson Graves and M.J. Morris, all of the City of Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho, have associated themselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State of Idaho, they do therefore make, sign and acknowledge these articles in triplicate, in writing, which when filed shall constitute the articles of incorporation of "The White Crystal Lime Company, Limited".

Article 1<sup>st</sup> :- The name of said company shall be "The White Crystal Lime Company, Limited".

Article 2<sup>nd</sup> :- The purposes for which said company is formed are, to manufacture, burn, and deal in lime; to locate purchase and hold placer mining claims and to sell the same; to buy and sell real estate; to acquire, purchase and hold quarries of lime stone, and locate, pre-empt and purchase lime stone and other rock under the laws of the United States; to build lime kilns and all other machinery and appliances necessary or convenient for the manufacture of lime and the carrying on the business of the company; to buy, sell and deal in any and all kinds of building materials; and generally to do any and all things proper for carrying on said business and for this purpose to have, possess and enjoy all the rights and benefits and privileges and immunities incident to the same, given under the laws of this State to corporations of such character.

Article 3<sup>rd</sup> :- The term of the existence of said company shall be fifty years.

Article 4<sup>th</sup> :- The capital stock of said company shall be One Hundred Thousand Dollars, divided into One Hundred Thousand Shares of the par value of
