ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

"WESLEYAN HOLINESS CHURCH OF NAMPA, IDAHO, INC."

(In triplicate)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the United States of America and are of full legal age, have this date voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation, and do by these Articles of Incorporation hereby form and incorporate under the laws of the State of Idaho and, in particular, Title 30, Chapter 11, of the Idaho Code, as amended, and do by these Articles of Incorporation unite ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to this end do adopt the following certificate of incorporation:

I.

That the name of this corporation shall be "WESLEYAN HOLINESS CHURCH OF NAMPA, IDAHO, INC."

II.

That the period of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

III.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

To establish a Wesleyan Holiness Church in Nampa, Canyon County, Idaho.

To buy, manage and own and hold real and personal property necessary and proper for a place of public worship, school and parish house.

To carry on educational and charitable work, under rules and regulations of a constitution to be adopted by the congregation of the above named church and the Wesleyan Holiness Association of Churches Declaration of Principles Manual 1969, provided said constitution and Manual provisions are to be in harmony with these Articles of Incorporation and the laws of the State of Idaho.

IV.

That the location and post office address of the registered office of said corporation is and shall be Nampa, Canyon County, Idaho.

V.

There shall be no capital stock of this corporation, either with or without value.

VI.

The By-Laws of this corporation shall provide the number and qualifications of members and the terms and conditions of admission to membership. The rights and interests of all members shall be equal and no member can have or acquire a greater interest than any other member; provided, however, that each member shall be a member of the Wesleyan Holiness Church.

VII.

The corporate powers of this corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors consisting of not less than three (3) or more than five (5) members and to be of a number as prescribed by the By-Laws of this corporation and to be elected as provided in said By-Laws. To be a director, a member must be in good standing of the Wesleyan Holiness Church of Nampa, Idaho, Inc. The powers and duties of the officers of this corporation shall be prescribed in the By-Laws.
