ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

U. S. GRANT RELIEF CORPS NO. 19, AUXILIARY TO GRAND ARMY OF THE REPUBLIC, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, whose names are affixed hereto, all being residents of the State of Idaho and full-age citizens of the United States of America, and all of whom have been duly elected directors of this corporation in accordance with its rules, regulations and by-laws, do, under and pursuant to Title 30 Chapter 11, Idaho Code and the general corporation laws of the State of Idaho pertaining thereto, hereby organize, constitute and associate ourselves, our members and such other persons as may hereafter become associated with us in accordance with these Articles, into a body politic and corporate, for purposes set forth, but not for pecuniary profit or advantage, and to that end we execute these Articles of Incorporation and certify, set forth, and declare:

ARTICLE I.

That the name of such corporation shall be U. S. Grant Relief Corps No. 19, Auxiliary to the Grand Army of the Republic, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

That the objects and purposes of said corporation shall be to aid and assist the Grand Army of the Republic and to perpetuate the memory of its heroic dead. To assist such Union Veterans and Veterans of all wars of the United States of America as need our help and protection and to extend needful aid to their widows and orphans. To find them homes and enjoyment

and to assure them of sympathy and friends. To cherish and emulate the deeds of our Army Nurses, and of all loyal women who rendered loving service to our Country in her hour of peril. To maintain true allegiance to the United States of America, to inculcate lessons of patriotism and love of country among our children and in the communities in which we live; and to encourage the spread of universal liberty and equal rights to all.

ARTICLE III.

ever which may be necessary for the business of the corporation and to carry out its fraternal, social and benevolent purposes, and to hold, use and dispose of the same as may be deemed best; and to lease, mortgage, exchange, transfer, and alienate any and all property as may be determined under the circumstances; to borrow money and issue evidence of such indebtedness in such manner advisable; to enter into and perform contracts of all kinds not inconsistent with these Articles and the laws governing corporations not organized for profit; to do all that necessary and convenient to accomplish such purposes.

ARTICLE IV.

That the registered office and place where the principal business of said corporation is to be transacted is Sandpoint, Bonner County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

That the existence of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VI.

That there shall be no capital stock but that membership herein shall be by virtue of being a member of this corporation according to the rules, regulations and by-laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII.

The corporate powers shall be vested in a board of three directors to be elected according to the by-laws. Powers and duties of such directors shall be prescribed in the by-laws. To be a director one must be a member in good standing. By-laws concerning the nomination, election or appointment of officers, directors or trustees and the installation, power and authority therein shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution, By-laws, Rules and Regulations of the National Women's Relief Corps, Auxiliary to the Grand Army of the Republic.
