

Be it Known, that we, whose names are  
hereunto subscribed, citizens of the United States and residents  
and citizens of the State of Idaho, under  
the authority of the statutes of said State, in that behalf do here-  
by constitute ourselves, & such other persons as may hereafter  
become members of the corporation hereby formed, into a body politic  
& corporate, and do hereby assume to and for the said corporation  
all the rights, powers, & privileges granted and conferred by the  
laws of the said State of Idaho. upon  
corporations of the kind hereby formed & created; and under & in  
pursuance of said statutes do hereby make & adopt the following

### Articles of Incorporation:

I. The name of this society is the Cottonwood Methodist  
Episcopal Church, Cottonwood, County of Idaho  
State of Idaho.

II. This incorporation is formed for the purpose of  
conducting and maintaining religious services & worship in accord-  
ance with the forms and usages of the Methodist Episcopal Church,  
as set forth in the Discipline of said Methodist Episcopal Church, as adopted  
& recognized from time to time by the General Conference of the said church.

Pecuniary profit is not the object of this association.

III. The place where the principal business of this corpo-  
ration is to be transacted is in Cottonwood, County of Idaho,  
State of Idaho.

IV. The members of this society shall at all times consist of the members  
of the local church connected therewith as shown by the church records.

V. The officers of this society shall consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary  
& Treasurer, & such other officers as the By-laws & Discipline of the church may provide, in-  
cluding a Board of Trustees, composed of five persons, two thirds of whom shall be  
members of the Methodist Episcopal Church. The Officers & Trustees shall be chosen, &  
all vacancies shall be filled by the Quarterly Conference, as from time to time provided  
by the Discipline of the Methodist Episcopal Church; and the duties of the several  
officers & of the Board of Trustees, & the limitations of their powers shall be, & are such as

are respectively prescribed & defined in said Discipline, & as provided in these articles  
& in any by-laws which may be adopted, in conformity with said Discipline & the laws of this  
State.

VII. The officers of the Board of Trustees shall consist of a President, Vice-President,  
Secretary & Treasurer, to be annually chosen by the board from among its members within  
the first quarter of the conference year following their election unless previously chosen  
by the Quarterly Conference; & the duties of said officers respectively shall be such as are  
usually imposed by their respective titles. The Board may, if deemed expedient,  
require the Treasurer to give bond & security for the funds & property coming in-  
to his hands for the society.

VIII. All the estate or property now held, or which may hereafter be acquired  
by this corporation, & the proceeds thereof, shall be held, used, & applied to the purchase & main-  
tenance of one or more church or churches, house or houses for divine worship, parsonage house  
or houses for the residence of the minister or ministers, in conformity with the usage, doc-  
tine & discipline of the Methodist Episcopal Church, as from time to time authorized and  
declared by the General Conference of the said Church, & the Annual Conference within whose  
bounds the premises are located situated.

IX. The society assumes to itself all the rights, powers, privileges & immuni-  
ties which are now, or which may, during the existence hereof be conferred by the law upon so-  
cieties of similar character, & except as herein modified, adopts as its by-laws the discipline  
of the Methodist Episcopal Church, so far as the same shall relate to societies of this character &  
to the officers & trustees thereof.

X. The general religious interest of the society shall be under the direction of the Bishop  
Presiding Elder, Pastor & Quarterly Conference having charge, in their respective spheres as provided  
by the discipline, but the permanent funds & property of the society shall be managed & controlled  
by the Board of Trustees, under the supervision of the Quarterly Conference. The following persons  
shall constitute the Board of Trustees for the first year, & until their successors are duly appointed:

W. A. Hall.

An election for said trustees was held in the town of Grangeville, County of  
Idaho, State of Idaho, on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of May 1873.

A majority of the members of this association were present & voted at such election, & the  
aforesaid persons were duly elected trustees as aforesaid for the first year & until their

successors are elected; & that A. W. Van Dusen & W. A. Hall were the officers  
conducting <sup>said</sup> election.
