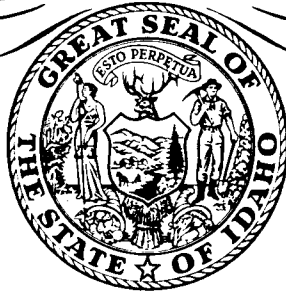

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
MICRO SECURITY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the United States of America, and over the age of twenty-one years, have voluntarily and lawfully associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and in pursuance thereof do hereby sign and acknowledge the following Articles of Incorporation, in triplicate, and do state as follows:

ARTICLE I.

Name

The name of this corporation shall be MICRO SECURITY, INC.

ARTICLE II.

Location and Post Office Address

That the location and post office address of this corporation shall be 1114 Front Street, Boise, Idaho, and the registered office of this corporation shall be at said address, but branch offices may be established either within or without the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III.

Objects and Purposes

That the objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed and the powers which it shall possess are as follows:

(a) To engage in the general business of micro-filming records, documents, and all other instruments pertaining to the operation of businesses of any nature whatsoever and buying and selling microfilming equipment of all kinds and nature whatsoever and performing all rights and duties incident thereto, including, but not necessarily limited to, the extraction of microfilm and cores from 16-mm film and other similar articles and doing all things reasonably required in connection with the general microfilming business.

(b) To purchase, secure, use, own, sell and enjoy any and all franchises useful and beneficial for the prosecution of the business of this corporation.

(c) To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, convey, mortgage, or lease real and personal property; dispose of, sell, lease, mortgage, assign, transfer or convey any rights, privileges, franchises, real or personal property of the corporation, other than its franchise of being a corporation; and to acquire, purchase, guarantee, hold, mortgage, own, vote, sell, assign, or otherwise dispose of or deal in shares, bonds, securities and debentures, and other evidences of indebtedness of other corporations, domestic or foreign, and while the holder of any shares of stock, to exercise all the rights and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote thereon to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.

(d) To purchase, acquire, hold, sell, transfer and issue the shares of its own capital stock, provided

it shall not use its funds or property for the purchase of its own shares of capital stock when such use would cause any impairment of the capital stock of this corporation.

(d) To enter into contracts or obligations of any type or kind essential, necessary, or proper to the transaction of its ordinary affairs, or for the purposes of the corporation.

(e) To borrow money or its notes, bonds or other obligations for the general purposes of the corporation, and to mortgage, pledge and give in trust any and all of its property, real and personal, to secure the payment thereof;

(f) To do all things incident to the general business of this corporation in the State of Idaho, in the other states, territories, and colonial possessions of the United States and in foreign countries, and to have one or more offices and places of business in or out of the State of Idaho, and to acquire, receive, hold, purchase, lease, mortgage, dispose of or convey real and personal property situated in or out of the State of Idaho; and then to hold such meetings of stockholders or directors as may seem necessary to the operation of their business;

(h) To do and perform all other things that may be found necessary or convenient or expedient to accomplish the stated purposes of this corporation. ~~It is further agreed~~ - It is that in the interpretation of this clause, the meaning of any of the objects of the company shall not be restricted by reference to or inference from any other object or the name of the company, or by juxtaposition of two or more objects, and

that in the event of any ambiguity, this charter shall be construed in such manner as to uphold and not to restrict the powers of the company. .

(1) To pay the expenses of and preliminary and incidental to the formation, establishment and organization of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV.

Capital Stock

11. Capital stock of this corporation shall be Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), which is divided into Ten Thousand (10,000) shares of the par value of One dollar (\$1.00) per share, all of which stock shall be non-assessable. Each and every share of such stock shall have the same rights and privileges as those enjoyed by each and every other of said shares.

ARTICLE V.

Gift of Stock

The Board of Directors of this corporation shall have the power and authority from time to time to authorize the sale of and to sell, for cash or otherwise, all or any portion of the unissued and/or of the treasury stock of this corporation without said stock or any part thereof being first offered to the shareholders of this corporation.

ARTICLE VI.

Duration

12. Duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VII.

Authority to Sublicense

The authority to sublicense of this corporation

is hereby expressly voted in the Board of Directors of this corporation, subject to the power of the shareholders to change or repeal this.

ARTICLE VIII.

Effective Date of Incorporation and Business

The effective date of this corporation to commence business shall be on the 1st day of June, 1965, and thence forward.

ARTICLE IX.

Directors

The number of the directors of this corporation shall not be less than three (3) nor more than five (5); the number, qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meeting, and the powers and duties of directors shall be such as are prescribed by the By-Laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE X.

Incorporators

The names and post office addresses of the incorporators and the number of shares subscribed by each, as well as the names of the directors who shall hold office and manage the affairs of the corporation for a period of one year after its incorporation and/or until their successors are elected and qualified at the first annual meeting of the shareholders are as follows:
