ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

BALES LUMBER CO., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WE, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the objective of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of the GENERAL CORPORATION LAWS of the State of Idaho and acts amending and supplementing said laws, and do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the Corporation is "BALES LUMBER CO., INC."

ARTICLE II.

The purposes and objects for which the corporation is formed are:

- To process, deal in, manufacture, install, store, handle, transport, or otherwise work in or with building materials of all kinds, including lumber, roofing, insulating materials, plaster, wall tile, ornamental and other boards, brick, concrete, structural steel, re-enforcing steel, glass, stone, pottery, tile, lighting fixtures, hardware, bathroom fixtures, plumbing supplies, electrical supplies, cements and plasters, stucco, stone and gravel, resinous waxes, textiles, incinerators, cesspools and septic tanks, fencing, wire and staples, water-proofing materials, rubber, linoleums, carpets, builders' tools and machinery, and any and every other material appurtenance or process useful in, necessary for, or convenient in building, construction, engineering and maintenance.
- To build, erect, construct, or cause to be constructed buildings, dwelling houses and structures of every other kind and nature.
- To acquire by purchase or lease, or otherwise, lands and interests in lands and to own, hold, improve, subdivide, develop, and manage any real estate so acquired and to erect or cause to be erected on any lands owned, held, or occupied by the corporation, buildings or other structures with their appurtenances, and to rebuild, enlarge, alter, or improve any buildings or other structures erected on any land so owned, held, or occupied, and to mortgage, sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of lands or interests in lands and in buildings or

- To purchase, own, improve, equip, operate and manage farms and farming property and to engage in any agricultural pursuit or undertaking, including, but not limited to the raising, purchasing, marketing and selling of livestock and poultry of every kind and nature and the produce therefrom.
- The power and capacity to act possessed by a natural person which acts are necessary or proper to accomplish the corporate purposes as above set out, or to fund any such operations, and which are not repugnant to the law, including, but not limited to all the powers and authorities nor or hereafter conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho upon corporations formed hereunder.
- To conduct business in the State of Idaho and other states, District of Columbia, territories and colonies of the United States, and in foreign countries, and to have one or more offices or places of businesses out of the state, and to acquire, receive, hold, purchase, lease, mortgage, dispose of or convey real and personal property situate out of this State.
- To purchase and re-issue the shares of its capital stock according to law. When such stock is owned by the corporation, such stock will not be considered voting stock directly or indirectly.

It is expressly provided that the enumeration of the foregoing 18 purposes and objects of the said Corporation shall not be construed to limit or restrict the general powers of the corporation, as provided by the statutory laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III.

The existence of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

The location of the registered office in this state shall be located in Caldwell, Canyon County, State of Idaho, and the Post Office address shall be 210 South 4th Avenue, Caldwell, Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

The total authorized number of par value shares is twenty-_and their aggregate par value is five hundred (2500)

Two Hundred Fifty Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$250,000.00). value per share is One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). The corporation shall not authorize the issuance of any no par value shares of stock. Such amount of any authorized but unissued shares or treasury stock of the corporation as the Board of Directors from time to time may deem wise, may be issued or sold at any time or times to such share holders, officers or employees of the corporation and for such consideration in money, property or services as the Board of Directors may determine, without prior offer of the same to the stockholders of the corporation, and no stockholder shall be entitled as a matter of right to subscribe for, purchase, or receive any part of such issue or sale of such capital stock of the corporation or shall have any pre-emptive or preferential right to subscribe for or purchase the same.

ARTICLE VI.

There shall be only one class of stock, and it shall be designated as common stock. The shares of stock shall not be issued until payment in full has been received, and such stock shall be non-assessable stock, and the shareholders shall have no liability for corporate obligations. Each share of stock shall have the voting rights as now or hereafter granted by the laws of the State of Idaho relating to corporations.

ARTICLE VII.

ARTICLE VIII.

The Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors which shall be governed by the By-Laws of said Corporation. The Board of Directors shall always be an odd number so that issues may normally be resolved. However, the number of directors shall not be less than three nor more than nine. The Board of Directors of the Corporation is hereby vested with the power to adopt, repeal and amend the By-Laws of the Corporation by a majority vote of the Directors.

ARTICLE IX

Amendment of these articles shall be accomplished only as now or hereafter prescribed by law relating to amendment of the Articles of Incorporation.
