ARTICLE 1 OF THE CONSTITUTION

of

THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

SECTION 1.

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2.

Clause 1.

The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

Clause 2.

Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be included within this Union, according to their respective Numbers, which shall be determined by adding to the whole Number of free Persons, including all bound Persons for the Space of one Year, who shall have arrived within the Limits of the said State, before the next Enumeration of the same, three fifths of all other Persons who shall have arrived within the said Limits, before the next Enumeration of the same.
