# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## THE BIOSE CITY BARRIAY AND REPRENAL COMPANY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaha, and especially Title Four of the Revised Statut-es of Idaha, 1887, we, the undersigned, a majority of whom are resident freeholders of the State of Idaha, have adopted and by these presents do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### ARTICLE FIRST

The name of this corporation shall be THE BOISE CHTY FAILWAY AND TERMINAL COMPANY.

### ARTICLE SECOND

The objects for which said corporation is formed are the following:

To construct, maintain and operate a line of standard guage railway and telegraph from a point on the line of the Oregon Short Line and Utah Northern Railway, in the northeast quarter of Section Eighteen (IC), Township Three (3) North of Hange Two (2) Hast of Boise Meridian; thence in a northeasterly direction through sections eighteen [18]. seven (7), eight (8), and nine (9) to the City of Baiso City; thence in a coutheasterly direction through said city of Boise City and section ten (10), eleven (11) and fourteen (14), to a point in the southwest quarter of Section thirteen (13), all of township three (3) north of range two (2) east Boise Meridian, County of Ada, State of Idaho, a distance of 5.57 miles, with such spurs, side tracks and branches as may be necessary, extending and radiating from said . line, through the streets and alleys of the said city of Boise City, Idaho, as aforesaid, and into and through any and all Additions now added or hereafter to be added to said sity of Boise City, and into and through said Ada County, as aforesaid.

And also to build, construct, maintain and operate railroad stations, freight houses, round houses, warehouses, store houses, machine shops, and any and all other structures necessary or appartenant to the business of a railroad and terminal company.

And also the right to build, purchase or leave warehouses and railroad tracks in the neighborhood of the said city of Baise city and in
the country adjacent thereto, including yards for neceiving and discharging freight; and to sell, lease, held, maintain and operate the
aforesaid property and any and all other property necessary or incidental to the carrying on of the insiness of a railroad and terminal
company, including the maintenance of depots, warehouses, store houses,
switch and spur tracks and sidings, and to change rates, rents of tolls
therefor.

### ARTICLE THIRD

The place where the principal business of the comporation is to be transacted shall be the city of Bodse City, in the County of Ada and state of Idahe.

## ARTICLE FOURTH

This corporation shall continue in existance for a period of falty (50) years from the twentieth day of Harch 1893.

### ARTICLE FIFTH

The musber of directors to manage the affairs of this corporation shall be five (5); the following are the names and residences of those appointed for the first year, who shall hold their office until others are elected as provided by the laws of the state of Idaho and the by-laws of the company:

D. C. Lockwood, Pocetello, Idaho.

G. W. Hoore, Boise City, Idaho.

Peter Sonna, Boise City, Idaho.

G. E. Crisman, Boise City, Idaho.

And the following shall be the first officers of the comporation who shall manage its affairs until their successors are duly elected by the board of directors:

E. E. Calvin, President, and Alexander Miller Secretary and James G. Harris Treasurer.

### ARTICLE SIXTH

The amount of the capotal stock of the composation shall be Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000), which shall be divided into Five Hundred (500) shares of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) cach.

This is to centify that on the 17th. day of February, 1896, there was held at the Passenger Depot of the Boise City Railway and Terminal Company, in Buice City, Ada County, Idaho, a stock holders meeting of the Boise City Railway and Terminal Company: said meeting was the regular annual meeting of said stockholders of said comperation; That said meeting was regularly called for the purnose of voting on the proposition to increase the capital stock of said comporation, by the addition of Thirty Thousand (\$20,000) dollars, and so as to make the gross capital stock the sim of eighty (\$20,000) thougand dellars: That a notice of said meeting to increase said capital stock was duly published in every issue of the Idaho Daily Statesman, a daily news-paper, published in Boise City, Ada County, Idaho, where the princapal place of business of said Boise City Railway and Temminal Company is located, for more than four weeks, beginning on Jamuary 18th, 1896, and continueing each day of publication down to the 16th day of February, 1896, both days inclusive; that said notice of meeting, and of proposition to increase capital stock, contained the amount to which it was proposed to increase the capital stock, to-wit, to increase it thirty thousand (\$30,000) dollars, so that the whole amount of capital stock would be eighty-thousand (\$80,000) dollars: That said meeting was regularly adjourned to 10 o'clock a.M., of February 84th, 1896, at the said passenger depot of said Company in Boise City: That on said date, February 24th, 1896, and at 10 o'clock a.m. at said place, said stockholders' adjourned meeting was held: that said adjournment had been made to further consider said proposition to so increase said stock, and to obtain certain domucents and papers before final action on said proposition and to elect directors for the ensuing year, and transact all other unfinished business of the regular meeting, and of

the special call to so increase said capital stock: That a total meeting, Peter Sonna was elected and acted as Chairman of the meeting, and C. E. Chrisman was elected and acted as Secretary thereof:

All of which shares voted in favor of said increase of said capttal stock, in the sum of thirty thousand dollars, so as to increase the capital stock of the Boise City Railway and Dirminal Company to the gross amount of eighty thousand dollars.

Inat two mindred twenty-eight (SSS) shares voted in vavor of said increase, and no shares voted against the said increase, and, that the voo being known, the chairman declared the proposition to increase said capital stock to eighty thousand dollars was carried;

was ropresented at said meeting, and no more;

There was present at, and laid before the meeting, and filed with its secretary, the written assent of the holders of over three fourths of the subscribed capital stock of said corporation to the said proposed increase of the capital stock, to-wit, the written assent of F. Gordon Dexter and Edwin F. Atkins, Trustees, holders of two hundred twenty four (224) shares:

by a vote of two hundred twenty-eight (288) shares, in fever thereof, and by no vote in opposition, increased thirty thousand (\$30,000) dol-lars, and to the gross amount of eighty thousand (\$80,000) dollars.
