KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

STATE OF IDAHO

That we, the undersigned, the President and Secretary respectively of

Calvary Chapel of Buhl, Inc., an Idaho nonprofit corporation, do hereby certify as follows:

That at a Special Meeting of the Board of Directors of Calvary Chapel of Buhl, Inc., held on the 18th day of April, 2002, a Resolution was regularly proposed, voted upon and adopted by all of said Directors amending the Articles of said corporation, and all of them voted in favor of said Amendment, and that the following is a true and correct copy of the Resolution of said Directors amending the Articles of said corporation to-wit:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Articles of Incorporation of Calvary Chapel of Buhl, Inc., be and the same are hereby amended as follows:

A.

Article 2 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distribution in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this article. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

B.

Article 8 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

Upon dissolution the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for the such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
