

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being citizens and residents of the United States of America and residents of the State of Washington, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, and to that end and purpose do make, subscribe and acknowledge these written Articles of Incorporation in triplicate, to-wit:

Ι

The name of this corporation shall be: VALLEY FOOD SERVICE, INC.

II

The objects for which this corporation are formed are:;

To carry on commercial enterprises relating to the

retail and wholesale marketing and distribution of pre-packaged

frozen food products, freezers, refrigerators and other products

incident thereto.

To carry on such other commercial enterprises of every kind and nature, retail and/or wholesale, and to buy, sell and deal in goods, wares and merchandise, personal and real property and services of every kind and description.

To build, acquire and operate commercial, industrial and residential buildings.

To engage in any and all activities and perform and exercise all rights and powers to the extent permitted by the laws of the State of Washington and/or any other State in which said corporation may be authorized to engage in business as the
