1 ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

3 THOMAS L. EDMARK, INC.

4 ARTICLE I.

5 The name of this corporation is THOMAS L. EDMARK, INC.

6 ARTICLE II.

7 Purposes

8 (a) To manufacture, buy, sell and deal in automobiles,
9 trucks, cars, boats, flying machines and other vehicles, their
10 parts and accessories, and kindred articles, and generally to con-
11 duct an automobile business in all its branches.

12 (b) To engage in a general garage, filling station, and
13 motor vehicle service and repair business.

14 (c) To purchase, sell, lease, make repairs to and store
15 automobiles, their parts and accessories, and to buy, sell and
16 lease and operate garages, service stations and repair shops and to
17 carry on business incidental thereto.

18 (d) To construct and erect buildings or structures upon
19 and to improve and maintain any and all real property owned, leased
20 or held by this corporation; and to equip, improve and generally
21 operate any and all personal property owned by this corporation.

22 (e) To purchase, hold, sell and transfer the shares of
23 its own capital stock; provided, it shall not use its funds or
24 property for the purchase of its own shares of capital stock when
25 such use would cause any impairment of its capital; and provided
26 further that the shares of its own capital stock owned by it shall
27 not be voted upon directly or indirectly.

28 (f) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts
29 of every sort and kind which may be necessary or desirable for the
30 furtherance of the business of this corporation, with any persons,
31 firms, corporations, associations, any state, territory, or muni-
32 cipality of the united States or any foreign country, government or
body politic.

(g) To acquire and hold all or any part of the capital
stock, assets or good will of any business, of any person, firm,
association or corporation engaged in any business in whole or in
part similar to that of this corporation, and to hold, utilize and
in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the stock, assets,
good will and rights so acquired and to conduct in any lawful manner
in whole or in part any business so acquired, and to undertake or
assume the whole or any part of the obligations or liabilities of
any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in the business
so acquired.

(h) To borrow money for any purpose of this corporation,
without limit as to amount, and to issue bonds, debentures, notes or
other evidences of indebtedness, secured or unsecured, of this

1 corporation for the moneys so borrowed, or in payment for property
2 acquired, or for any other objects or purposes of this corporation,
3 or in connection with its business; to secure payment of such de-
4 bentsures, notes or other obligations by mortgages or pledges or
5 other liens upon any or all of the property of this corporation
6 wheresoever situated.

7 (i) To carry out all or any part of the foregoing objects,
8 or purposes as principal or agent, or otherwise, either alone or in
9 conjunction with any person, association or other corporation and
10 in any part of the world; and in carrying on its business and for
11 the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its objects or purpos-
12 es, to make and perform such contracts of any kind and description,
13 to do such acts and such things, and to exercise any and all such
14 powers as a natural person could lawfully make, perform, do or
15 exercise, provided that the same be not inconsistent with the objects
16 or purposes of this corporation, or the statutes of the State of
17 Idaho.

18 (j) To conduct its business in all or any of its branches
19 in the State of Idaho, and in any and all other states, territories,
20 possessions, colonies and dependencies of the United States of
21 America and in the District of Columbia, and in any or all foreign
22 countries, and to have one or more offices within or outside of the
23 State of Idaho.

24 (k) The objects as specified herein shall, except as
25 otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference
26 to or inference from the terms of any other clause or paragraph of
27 these Articles. The objects, purposes and powers specified in each
28 of the clauses or paragraphs in these Articles shall be regarded as
29 independent objects, purposes and powers.

30 The foregoing shall be construed as objects and powers and
31 the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrain in
32 any manner the general powers now or hereafter conferred on this
33 corporation by the statutes of the State of Idaho.

34 ARTICLE III.
35 Duration

36 The period of existence and the duration of the life of
37 this corporation shall be perpetual.

38 ARTICLE IV.
39 Place of Business

40 The location and post office address of the registered
41 office of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be Caldwell
42 in the County of Canyon, State of Idaho.

43 ARTICLE V.
44 Stock

45 This corporation is authorized to issue one class of
46 shares of its capital stock to be designated as common stock; the
47 total number of shares of common stock which this corporation shall
48 be authorized to issue is 1,000. The aggregate par value of the
49 capital stock of this corporation shall be \$100,000.00; and the par
50 value of each of said shares of common stock shall be \$100.00.

15 Capital stock

16 The capital stock of this corporation shall be non-
17 assessable; and the private property of the shareholders in this
18 corporation shall not be liable for the debts, obligations or
19 liabilities of this corporation.

20 ARTICLE VIII.

21 A director of this corporation shall not be required to
22 be a holder of any of the shares of the common capital stock of the
23 corporation.
