ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

AURORA INDUSTRIES, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States of America and residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation for the business purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the Business Corporation Act of the State of Idaho, and do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE ONE

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be AURORA INDUSTRIES, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

PURPOSES

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

To own, rent, lease or maintain any building or buildings necessary for the housing and carrying on of the purposes of said corporation;

To own, rent, lease or maintain any and all personal property incidental to the carrying on of the purposes of said corporation;

To deal in its own corporate stock, borrow money, contract debts, make contracts and to exercise any and all such powers as a natural person can lawfully make, do, perform or exercise, which may be expedient, necessary or convenient for the accomplishment of any of its objectives or purposes, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Idaho, and that the end enumeration of such purposes or powers shall not be deemed conclusive. Said corporation is awarded all the powers and privileges granted under the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE THREE

DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE FOUR

LOCATION

The location and post office address of said corporation shall be P. O. Box 12, Inkom, Idaho, 83245.

ARTICLE FIVE

AUTHORIZED STOCK

The total authorized number of par value shares is 1,000 shares of common stock of the par value of \$100.00 per share. The total aggregate value of the authorized shares is \$100,000.00. Each share of stock is equal to any other and entitles the holder thereof to one (1) vote for each share of stock held by him or her.
