ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

CROWTHER'S, INC.

BE IT KNOWN That we, the undersigned persons, all being of full age and citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and

WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

1. The name of the proposed corporation is Crowther's, Inc.
2. The purposes of the corporation are:

To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign and transfer, or otherwise dispose of, to invest, trade, deal in and deal with, goods, wares, securities and merchandise and real and personal property of every class and description;

To engage in any commercial, industrial, and agricultural enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to this corporation and in conformity with the laws of the State of Idaho;

To generally engage in, do, and perform any enterprise, act, or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform;

To do all and everything necessary, suitable, and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, or individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things, incidental or appertenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid objects or purposes or any part or parts thereof, provided the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

3. The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

4. The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation in the State of Idaho, is Malad City, County of Oneida.

5. The authorized number of par value shares is 5,000. The aggregate par value of the total authorized number of par value shares is \$5,000.00. The stock of the corporation consists of 5,000 shares of common stock, all of which shall have equal voting power and the property rights and interests of the members shall be equal.




7. The private property of the stockholders of the Corporation shall not be liable for debts or liabilities of the Corporation.


