

AMENDMENT AND ADDITION TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, being the officers of the Liberty Street Church of Christ, in due regard to the resolution made and unanimously passed by a quorum of the membership of the Liberty Street Church of Christ in a meeting on January 31, 1983, do hereby come together with the purpose of amending and adding to the Articles of Incorporation of the Liberty Street Church of Christ in the following manner:

Article IV of the original Articles of Incorporation shall hereby be amended to further define the purposes of the corporation to be as follows. In addition to the purposes originally stated, the corporation shall also exist for these purposes:

The purpose of this corporation shall henceforth be defined as the continuance of a free church. It is the church's purpose to do all things to safeguard and transmit to all members and posterity the purity and righteousness of individual freedom, and the teachings of the church of Christ. Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). We hereby dedicate our assets to these purposes.

These articles shall be added to the existing articles:

Article IX: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its stated purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, neither shall it participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of the Articles of Incorporation or these amendments and additions, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on:

(a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Sections 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or

(b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article X: Should this corporation ever be dissolved the trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all remaining assets of the corporation by distribution to another organization or organizations whose purposes are most nearly akin to those of this corporation, which shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). Any assets not so disposed of shall pass by the laws of the State of Idaho for distribution in furtherance of these purposes or those promulgated by State Law.

These amendments and additions shall henceforth be legal and binding to the body of Articles of Incorporation of the Liberty Street Church of Christ. Witnesseth our hands this 7th day of February, in the year of our Lord 1983.
