ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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OF

SHOSHONE COUNTY WOMEN'S RESOURCE CENTER, INC.

Debbie Scudder, Karen P. Hopper and Betty Sullivan, being each over the age of twenty-one (21) years and citizens of the United States of America, for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the provisions of Chapter 1 and 3, Title 30, Idaho Code, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I

The name of this corporation shall be SHOSHONE COUNTY WOMEN'S RESOURCE CENTER, INC.

Article II

The period of duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

Article III

This corporation shall be a non-profit corporation.

Article IV

This corporation may be dissolved in the manner as prescribed by the laws of the State of Idaho. No member shall have any interest in the assets of this corporation during its life or upon dissolution. In the event of dissolution, the assets of this corporation shall be converted to cash and after payment of all debts and other liabilities, any residue of funds shall be donated to a charitable organization of any type.

Article V

The address of the registered office of this corporation is: Box 792, 201 Ohio Street, Kellogg, Idaho 83837, and the name of its registered agent at such address is Karen P. Hopper.

Article VI

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- (a) To Assist North Idaho persons whose economic, physical, and emotional needs are not now being met by existing local, state and federal agencies and to assist these persons in remaining informed on local, state and federal issues that directly effect their social, economic, legal and physical well-being.
- (b) To encourage and work towards the reduction of violence toward women through education and crisis intervention including counseling, shelter and advocacy.
- (c) To encourage opportunities for education with emphasis on life style education and life planning.
- (d) To encourage the awareness of support systems within our community as a result of an information and referral service. To develop and maintain such an information and referral service.

Article VII

Individuals, corporations, associations and partnerships may become members of this corporation subject to any restrictions thereof by the constitution or the laws of the State of Idaho.

Article VIII

This corporation shall be formed without capital stock. Membership certificates may be issued to each member and shall not be assignable. The voting power, rights and interest of each member shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest than any other member. The terms and conditions of admission to membership shall be prescribed by the Bylaws. The members of this corporation shall not be personally liable for the debts, liabilities or obligations of the corporation.

Article IX

The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation

in the manner now and hereafter prescribed by the laws of the State of Idaho, and all rights conferred upon the members of the corporation herein are granted subject to this reservation.

Article X

The Board of Directors shall have the full power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal the Bylaws or adopt new Bylaws in the manner prescribed by statute. Nothing herein shall deny the concurrent power of the members to adopt, alter, amend, or repeal the By Laws.

Article XI

The number, qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meetings, and powers and duties of the directors shall be prescribed in the Bylaws, but the number of the first directors shall be three (3), and they shall serve until the first meeting of members and until their successors are elected and qualified, and their names and post office addresses are as follows:
