

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of
Our Lady of Einsiedeln Traditional Roman Catholic Church; Inc.
A Non-Profit Corporation

Article I Name

The name of the Corporation is Our Lady of Einsiedeln Traditional Roman Catholic Church, Inc. a non-profit corporation.

Article II Duration

The period of the corporation's duration is perpetual.

Article III Purpose

This corporation shall be a non-profit corporation, as the purposes of this corporation are to be religious and charitable, and to establish and maintain a church with the following objectives:

(a) The advancement of the Traditional Roman Catholic Faith through public worship, missionary endeavors, including work with young people, particularly neglected youth, and the consistent Catholic living of its members.

- (b) To receive and hold all kinds of property, both real and personal or mixed, which it may acquire by purchase, donation, gift, bequest, or devise, or property otherwise necessary to accomplish the objectives of the corporation; to sell, convey, invest, assign or lease real and personal property of any nature or description; to enter into, perform and carry out contracts of any kind necessary, in connection with or incident to, the accomplishment of the purpose of this corporation.
- (c) To transact any legal business under the laws of the State of Idaho, or the laws of the state in which the corporation may be operating to further the precepts of the Traditional Roman Catholic Faith.

Article IV Members

Every member of Our Lady of Einsiedeln Traditional Roman Catholic Church shall be members of the Corporation. However, this religious corporation shall never issue stock or bonds and no dividends shall be paid. In case of final dissolution of this corporation, after payment of its debts, its assets, including real estate, if any, shall be transferred or conveyed at the direction of the Boardd of Directors to a religious organization which is qualified as an exempt religious organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal revenue Code as amended.

Article V Administration

The management of this corporation shall remain vested in and be carried out by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall be not less than three, including the Pastor of Our Lady of Einsiedeln Traditional Roman Catholic Church, Inc., the financial advisor (appointed by the Pastor), and the property maintenance operator (appointed by the Pastor).

Article VI Liability of Officers

The private property, both real and personal, of the officers of this corporation shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts but shall be exempt from liability thereof.

Article VII Registered Office and Agent

The address of the corpoation's initial registered office is HC-1 Box 213 (740 Paisely Road), Spirit Lake, ID 83869, and the name of the registered agent at this address is Rev. Gerald Kasik.

Article VIII Bylaws

The Directors of this corporation have authority to adopt its initial bylaws with any provisions found to be appropriate, convienient or necessary for the management of its affairs and not inconsistent with applicable law of these Articles of Incorporation, and from time to time in the manner set out therein to alter, amend, or revoke all or any part of its bylaws.

Article IX Incorporation
