ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

NEW PLYMOUTH VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, INC.

THE Undersigned, acting as the incorporators of a nonprofit corporation (Corporation) organized under and pursuant to the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, Chapter 3, title 30, Idaho Code (Act), adopts the following Articles of Incorporation (Articles).

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is New Plymouth Volunteer Fire Department, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Nonprofit Status

The Corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

ARTICLE III

Period of Duration

The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

Registered Office and Agent

The location of the Corporation is in the City of New Plymouth, County of Payette, and in the State of Idaho. The address of the initial registered office is 6110 Custer Road, New Plymouth, Idaho 83655, and the name of the initial registered agent at this address is Jerry Stelling.

ARTICLE V

Purposes

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized and will be operated are as follows:

A. The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are charitable, and are to concern themselves with the provision of assistance, monetarily and otherwise, to members of the community, including, but not necessarily limited to, assistance to members of the community who have suffered loss from fire or other disasters.

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- B. Charitable or educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt under such Section 501(c)(3).
- C. To exercise all powers granted by law necessary and proper to carry out the foregoing purposes, including, but not limited to, the power to accept donations of money, property, whether real or personal, or any other things of value. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize or permit the corporation to carry on any business for profit, to exercise and power, or to do any act that corporation formed under the act, or any amendment thereto or substitute therefore, may not at time lawfully carry on or do.

ARTICLE VI

Limitations

No part of the net earnings or the assets of the Corporation shall inure to the benefits of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article V hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be for carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986, as amended from time to time.

ARTICLE VII

Members

The Corporation shall have members, Said members shall consist of those persons who meet all the requirements and qualification and serve in the capacity as a volunteer fireman for the City/Rural of New Plymouth.

ARTICLE VIII

Board of Directors

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The number of Directors service on the Board of Directors shall be fixed in accordance with the Corporation's Bylaws. Other than the Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors, who were designated in these Articles, the Directors shall be elected by the existing Directors of the Corporation in the manner and for the term provide in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IX

Distribution on Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation, distribute all of the assets of the Corporation to a nonprofit corporation qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, selected by the Board of Directors, in such manner as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so distributed shall be distributed by the district court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for the purposes or to such organizations, as such court shall determine to be consistent with the purposes of the Corporation.

ARTICLE X

Incorporator

ARTICLE XI

Bylaws

Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the Corporation shall be set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE XII

Amendment of Bylaws

The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be authorized to amend the Corporation's Bylaws at a properly noticed special or regular meeting of the Board of Directors.
