**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FIRST, The name of corporation shall be "Vanguard Military Academy, Inc."
STATE OF IDAHO

SECOND, Its registered office in the State of Idaho is to be located at 10851 Blackhawk Drive, in the City of Boise, County of Ada. The initial registered agent in charge thereof is Kayla Ann McRill at 10851 Blackhawk Drive, Boise, Idaho 83709. The corporation may have other offices, within or without the State of Idaho as the board of directors may designate.

THIRD, The nature of the business and objects and purposes proposed to be transacted, promoted and carried on, are to do any and all things herein mentioned, as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, in any part of the world, and as it may be amended from time to time, viz.:

"The purpose for which the corporation is to engage, but is not limited to, the transaction of any lawful act or activity which may contribute to the training and education of youth and adults, which may promote discipline, leadership, values, patriotism, self esteem, work or study skills, or other worthy endeavors. Such initial intention shall in no manner limit the corporation from extending this purpose for the benefit of its members, or the communities in which it serves. "

FOURTH, The board of directors shall consist initially of the following individuals. Otherwise, the number of persons to serve on the board of directors shall be fixed by the board of directors, and may be amended from time to time, but at no time shall be less than three (3).

Articles of Incorporation of Vanguard Military Academy

FIFTH, The name and address of the Incorporator of the corporation is Kayla Ann McRill, 10851 Blackhawk Drive, Boise, Idaho 83709.

SIXTH, The corporation shall have memberships designated by classes. The qualifications, limitations, obligations, and rights in effect for each stated class as defined by the board of directors, and not otherwise provided for in the Bylaws, shall be set forth in the regulations, and may be changed or amended from time to time as determined by the board.

SEVENTH, Dissolution of the corporation shall be authorized if approved by a majority of the board of directors, or as required by law. In the event of dissolution of the corporation assets will be distributed in the following manner:

- a) Property will be liquidated to the extent necessary to satisfy outstanding liabilities and obligations.
- b) Remaining property may be distributed to the membership, or to the benefactors of the corporation's services, as is seen fit by the board of directors.
