and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service
Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 29,
Idaho Code, Annotated.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CHURCH OF NAZAARENE
COEUR D'ALENE, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, whose names are hereby affixed, and all of whom have been duly elected directors of the Church of the Nazarene of Coeur d'Alene in accordance with its rules, regulations and by-laws, do under and in pursuance of Section 29, Chapter 11, of the Idaho Code Annotated as amended, and the general corporation laws of said State hereby organize, constitute and associate ourselves and such other persons as may hereafter become associated with us, in accordance with these Articles, into a body politic and corporate, for the purposes hereinafter set forth, but not for pecuniary profit or advantage, and to that end we execute these Articles of Incorporation, and hereby certify, set forth and declare as follows:

I.

NAME.

The name of this corporation is and shall be "CHURCH OF THE NAZARENE, INC." COEUR D'ALENE.

II

OBJECTS AND PURPOSES

The general purpose and plan of operation of this corporation shall be to establish a Church of the Nazarene in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, to buy, manage, and own and hold real and personal property necessary and proper for a place of public worship, school and parish house, carry on educational and charitable work, under rules and regulations of a constitution to be adopted by the congregation of the above named church, said constitution to be in harmony with these articles of incorporation and the laws of the State of Idaho.

III.

PLACE OF BUSINESS

That the place where the principal business of this Corporation shall be transacted, and the registered Post Office of said Corporation, is and shall be Coeur d'Alene, Idaho.

IV.

CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The corporate existence of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

V.

MEMBERSHIP

There shall be no capital stock of this Corporation, but all members of the Church of the Nazarene of Kootenai County, Idaho, shall by virtue of such membership be members of this Corporation.

VI.

DIRECTORS

The corporate powers of this corporation shall be vested in a Board of four (4) Directors, to be elected as provided in the By-laws of this Corporation. To be a Director, a member must be in good standing of the Church of the Nazarene of Coeur d'Alene, Inc.

The powers and duties of the officers of this Corporation shall be prescribed in the by-laws.

being first duly sworn, each for himself and not one for the other, upon oath deposes and says: That on the 27th day of May, 1944 at the hour of eight o'clock P.M. of said day at 723-11th Street, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, a meeting was held for the purpose of electing a Board of Directors of this Corporation; that at such meeting the said Earl D. Hunter and Sadie Arthur

WERE chosen as Chairman and Secretary respectively, of said meeting and were the officers, who conducted the election, then and there held. That notice of the time and place of said meeting was given by publication as required by law, once a week for two full weeks in the Coeur d'Alene Press, a daily newspaper printed and published in the City of Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho, and on its date of legal publication, and where said election was held, and by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where said election was to be held, for the same period, and said notice being the words and figures as follows:

NOTICE

Pursuant to Section 29-1102 of the Idaho Code Annotated, Notice is hereby given by the Church of the Nazarene, that on the 27th day of May, 1944, at the hour of 8 o'clock P. M. at the church building of said religious society, at 723 N. 11th St. Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, an election will be held at said time and place for the purpose of election of Directors or other Boards of said religious society, and for the purpose of incorporation said society under the laws of the State of Idaho.
