We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, at least two of whom are citizens of the State of acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Non-Protit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles for such corporation.

This corporation is limited to such as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Internal Revenue Section 501 (c) (4). This corporation will not, as a substantial part of its activities carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation This corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE V

This corporation recognizes the National Organization, known as Disabled American Veterans, incorporated by Act of Congress, and affirms its allegiance, and subordination, to said National Organization, its Constitution Bylaws and all rules, mandates and regulations promulgated pursuant thereto
