ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together, and do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the general corporation laws of the State of Washington and acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, and do certify as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The corporate name of this corporation shall be: HEGE CO.

ARTICLE II.

The nature of the business and the purposes for which the corporation is formed are:

- (1) To engage in the general real estate business and in the business of a broker, to act as the agent for others or to act for itself in the purchase, sale, renting, or management of real estate and household interest therein and personal property of whatsoever and kind.
- (2) To engage in the general mortgage loan business; to originate loans for itself or for others on real or personal property or to borrow the said money on bonds and notes secured by mortgages or trust deeds on real estate or leaseholds; to act as trustee in deeds of trust or mortgages on real or personal property, or any evidences of value to secure them.
- (3) To act as agent for insurance companies and to solicit and receive application for fire, casualty, accident,

health, burglary, rent, credit, life insurance and all other kinds of insurance; to collect premiums and to transact other business as may be delegated to an agent by such companies; to engage in the business of selling bonds of all types; to conduct a general insurance agency and general brokerage business.

(4) To acquire by purchase, or lease, or otherwise, lands and interests in lands, whether for investment or its own use, or to protect existing interests therein or for other purposes and to own, hold, improve, develop, subdivide, plat and sell the same, and to erect or cause to be erected on any lands owned, held or occupied by the corporation, buildings, or other structures with their appurtenances, and to rebuild, enlarge, alter or improve any buildings or other structures, and to construct or cause to be constructed curbs, streets, sidewalks, curbing, and the doing of any other work in connection with the development of a subdivision.

(5) To purchase, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire and own, hold, use, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, exchange, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every kind and description, including shares of stock, bonds, debentures, notes, evidences of indebtedness, and other securities, contracts, or obligations of any corporation or corporations, composition or associations, domestic or foreign, and to pay therefor in whole or in part in cash or by exchanging therefor stocks, bonds or other evidences of indebtedness or securities of this or any other corporation, and while the owner or holder of any such real or personal property, stocks, bonds, debentures, notes, and the

of indebtedness or other securities, contracts, and obligations, to receive, collect, and dispose of the principal dividends and income arising from such property, and to possess and exercise in respect thereof, all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the voting powers on any stocks so owned.

(6) To construct, assemble, alter, decorate, maintain, furnish, fit and approve buildings of every sort and kind.

(7) To borrow money, to issue bonds, notes, debentures or other obligations of this corporation from time to time for any of the objects or purposes of this corporation, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust or otherwise, and to issue the same unsecured.

(8) To lend money, to purchase, acquire, own, hold, guarantee, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of capital in, shares, bonds, notes, debentures, or other securities or evidences of indebtedness of any other person, corporation or association, whether domestic or foreign, and whether now or hereafter organized or existing; and while the holder thereof, to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote thereon, to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.

(9) To purchase and acquire its own shares in the manner provided by law.

(10) To carry on any business whatsoever which this corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the foregoing purposes or otherwise, and which may be calculated directly or indirectly to promote the

interests of this corporation or to enhance the value of its property or business; to conduct its business in this state, in other states, in the District of Columbia, in the territories and colonies of the United States, and in foreign countries, and to hold, purchase, mortgage and convey real and personal property, either in or out of the State of Washington, and to have and to exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of Washington upon corporations formed under the laws pursuant to and under which this corporation is formed, as such laws are now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended.

The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, and the purposes and powers stated in each clause shall, except where otherwise expressed, be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms or provisions of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes.

#### ARTICLE III.

The location and business office address of the registered office of the corporation in the State of Washington is: First and Wall, Spokane, Washington.

#### ARTICLE IV.

The total authorized number of shares of stock which this corporation is authorized to issue is 1000 shares, and the par value of each share is \$100.

#### ARTICLE V.

The amount of paid-in capital with which the corporation will begin business is \$25,000.

ARTICLE VI.

The first directors shall hold office until January 1, 1955, and thereafter until their successors are elected at a meeting of the shareholders, and their names and post office addresses are as follows:
