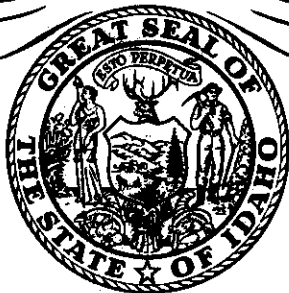

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT OF SCOTTCO, INC.

William L. Scott, President, and Marie J. Scott, Secretary, of the above named corporation, respectfully show that:

The above named corporation was organized under the laws of the State of Idaho on January 16, 1964.

The above named corporation has by written consent of all of the shareholders of said corporation, and pursuant to Idaho Code Section 30-14b, amended and hereby does amend its Articles of Incorporation, by amending ARTICLE FIFTH to read as follows:


FIFTH


The capital stock of the corporation is composed of common stock and preferred stock. The authorized number of shares of common stock is 500. The par value of the shares of common stock is \$100.00 per share. The authorized number of shares of preferred stock is 60. The par value of the preferred stock is \$1,000.00 per share. The preferred stock is non-dividend paying stock and is preferred as to liquidation only. The corporation may at the time of issuance of any of the preferred stock agree to repurchase said preferred stock from the holder thereof at such time and in such manner as the corporation may agree, which agreement may be at the option of the holder of said preferred stock, and such agreement is binding on the corporation. All common stock and preferred stock is voting stock, each share thereof being entitled to one vote.

The total number of shares including those previously authorized which the corporation is now authorized to have is 500 shares of common stock and 60 shares of preferred stock. All of the shares of stock have a par value, the shares of common stock having a par value of \$100.00 per share and the shares of preferred stock having a par value of \$1,000.00 per share.

The shares of stock are divided into common stock and preferred stock. The holders of the common stock and the preferred stock are entitled to one vote per share of stock. The preferred stock is non-dividend paying stock, preferred as to liquidation only. The preferred stock may be issued by the corporation pursuant to an agreement that the corporation will repurchase the said preferred stock at such time and under such conditions and terms as the corporation may agree.

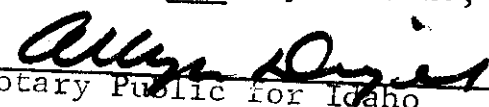
