Franklin Domestic Water Users Association, Inc Amendment to the articles of Incorporation

Article 2: Purpose for which the corporation is organized

Said organization is organized exclusively to own, operate, maintain and manage a water collection, storage and distribution system. This system would provide water for the mutual and beneficial use of the owners or occupants of lots 1, 2, 5, 6, and 8 – 24 of R & V Subdivision and provide water for domestic use and irrigation. It qualifies as an exempt organization under section 501 (c) (12) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code applying to like organizations.

Article 8: Dissolution of the corporation

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(12) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code applying to like organizations.
