

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, E. G. Meyers, Ed. Myer and R. Nickodemus, all of Twin Falls, Idaho, having been duly elected trustees and directors of the Evangelical-Lutheran Immanuel-Congregation of Twin Falls, Idaho, in pursuance of the purpose of our election, hereby, together with the other voting members of said Congregation, associate ourselves for the purpose of forming a religious corporation, of which pecuniary profit is not the object, under the laws of the State of Idaho; and we do hereby certify and declare:

### ARTICLE I.

The name of said corporation is and shall be, "EVANGELICAL - LUTHERAN IMMANUELS - CONGREGATION OF TWIN FALLS, IDAHO."

### ARTICLE II.

The objects and purposes for which said corporation shall be and is formed are the maintenance of said Congregation, the preaching of the word of God in all its ~~purety~~ truth and purity, the administration of the sacraments as instituted by Christ Jesus, and the religious instruction of our youth; and, as incident to the principal purposes of said corporation, said corporation has and shall have power and authority to purchase, lease, own, hold, control, sell, mortgage and improve sufficient real and personal and mixed property for the business and objects and purposes of said corporation.

### ARTICLE III.

The place where the principal business of said corporation shall be transacted and where its principal church organization and religious enterprises shall be carried on, is and shall be the city of Twin Falls, in Twin Falls County, State of Idaho.

### ARTICLE IV.

The term for which said corporation shall exist is and shall be as follows:

Upon making and filing for record these articles of incorporation the board of trustees and directors and the persons subscribing these articles as such trustees and directors, and their successors in office by the name or title of Trustees and Directors of Evangelical-Lutheran Immanuel-Congregation of Twin Falls, Idaho, shall thereafter be deemed as official representatives of said corporation, which is hereby created a body politic, with continual perpetual succession, and shall have power to acquire and possess, by donation, gift, bequest, devise or purchase, and to hold and maintain, property, real, personal and mixed, and to grant, sell, convey, rent, or otherwise dispose of the same as may be necessary to carry on or promote the objects of said corporation; and said corporation shall have power to borrow money and to give written obligations therefor, and to secure the payment thereof by mortgage or other lien, upon real or personal property, when necessary to promote said objects.

#### ARTICLE V.

The number of the trustees and directors of said corporation shall be three, and the names and residence of those who are appointed to manage the affairs and concerns of said corporation for the first year are as follows: E. G. Meyers, Ed. Myer and R. Nickodemus, all residing at Twin Falls, in Twin Falls County, State of Idaho.

#### ARTICLE VI.

The estimated value of the property belonging to said Congregation and corporation at the time of making these articles of incorporation is Two Thousand Dollars.

#### ARTICLE VII.

The title of the persons making these articles of incorporation is, "Trustees and Directors of Evangelical-Lutheran Immanuel-Congregation of Twin Falls, Idaho."

#### ARTICLE VIII.

Each and every member of said Congregation is and shall be a member of said corporation.

Said corporation not being for pecuniary profit, there is not any capital stock of said corporation.

ARTICLE IX.

With the object and purpose of forming said corporation, an election was held at Twin Falls, in Twin Falls County, Idaho, on the 13th day of June, 1909, at which meeting all the members of said Congregation were present and in which all of said members participated and voted, and at which said meeting said E. G. Meyers, Ed. Myer and R. Nickodemus were unanimously elected as said trustees and directors of said corporation, as above set forth.
