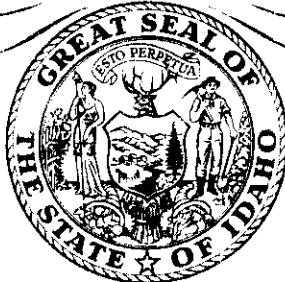

### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

**ST. PAUL'S METHODIST CHURCH OF IDAHO FALLS, INC.**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Thirty-First** day of **August,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty,** and is duly recorded on Film No. **112** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Idaho Falls,** in the County of **Bonneville,** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ST. PAUL'S METHODIST CHURCH OF IDAHO FALLS,  
INC.

We, the undersigned, do hereby certify that we are the duly elected Board of Trustees of St. Paul's Methodist Church of Idaho Falls, a religious organization, and duly authorized and directed to form this corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and the Discipline of the Methodist Church.

I.

The corporate name of this corporation shall be:

"St. Paul's Methodist Church of Idaho  
Falls, Inc."

II.

The purposes and objects for which said corporation is formed are:

To establish and maintain a Methodist Church and to provide a place of public worship in said town of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, State of Idaho; to establish, maintain and conduct schools for the religious education of the young and to further other religious and charitable work; to promote the Kingdom of God in our lives and in the life of the community; to maintain and conduct meetings for proper worship, for prayer and for Christian education and for the development of the highest social life; to promote the religious, moral, intellectual and physical well-being of individuals by providing and maintaining for them, halls, rooms, libraries, playgrounds, gymnasiums and school rooms for the purpose of religious, educational and industrial instruction; to provide friendly counsel, advice and assistance, the same to be maintained in whole or in part or assisted by the corporation; and to encourage every work for the furtherance of religious belief that the members may see fit to undertake.

III.

That the place where the principal business is to be transacted shall be Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho.

IV.

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

V.

The corporation shall support the doctrine, and it, and all its property, both real and personal, shall be subject to the laws, usages and ministerial appointments of The Methodist Church as are now or shall be from time to time established, made, and declared by the lawful authority of the said church.

VI.

The Board of Directors of the corporation shall be the Board of Trustees of the local church, elected and organized as prescribed in the Discipline of The Methodist Church.

VII.

The corporation shall have the power to acquire and hold title in fee simple, in trust, or otherwise, to both real and personal property, and to improve, encumber, sell, convey, and dispose of all such property in conformity with the Discipline of The Methodist Church.

VIII.

Subject to the provisions of the Discipline, the corporation shall have the power to erect and maintain buildings for the worship of God, for training in Christian faith and conduct, and for Christian social intercourse, and to acquire or build and maintain residences for the use and occupancy of its ministers.

IX.

The by-laws of the corporation shall include the Discipline of The Methodist Church as from time to time enacted, authorized and declared by its General Conference; and no other by-law shall be adopted inconsistent with the provisions

3 The members of the corporation shall be/members of the  
4 Quarterly Conference, or such other body of the local church as  
5 the local laws may permit or require.

6 XI.

7 If, for any reason, the corporation shall cease to exist  
8 as a legal entitiy and its charter shall expire or be terminated,  
9 the title to all its property, both real and personal, shall be  
10 vested in the trustees of the Annual Conference, if the Annual  
11 Conference itself is unincorporated, in the same manner as it  
12 holds title to any other real estate, or in the Annual Conference  
13 in its corporate name if it is incorporated; and all such  
14 property shall be held in trust for the benefit of the local  
15 church.

16 XII.

17 The Board of Trustees of this Corporation shall consist  
18 of not fewer than three (3) nor more than nine (9) persons,  
19 each of whom shall be not less than 21 years of age, and at  
20 least two-thirds of whom shall be members of the Methodist  
21 Church.

22 XIII.

23 This corporation is formed for religious purposes and  
24 not for profit.

25 XIV.

26 The members of this corporation shall not be liable for the  
27 debts of this corporation.

28 That public notice of the election of the Board of Trustees  
29 and the intent to incorporate said congregation was given by  
30 publication at least once a week for two weeks in the Post  
31 Register, a newspaper published in Idaho Falls, Bonneville County,  
32 Idaho, the city in which said meeting was held, and also posted

at the place where the meeting was held. At the meeting a majority of the congregation were present and voted, and the undersigned were unanimously elected the Board of Trustees for the congregation and were duly authorized and directed to proceed with the incorporation of said congregation.

Jacoby, Jack C. Riddlemoser, William F. Zelezny, Charles W. Reich and George Barton were duly elected the Board of Trustees of said Church.


At said meeting the following resolution was adopted:


