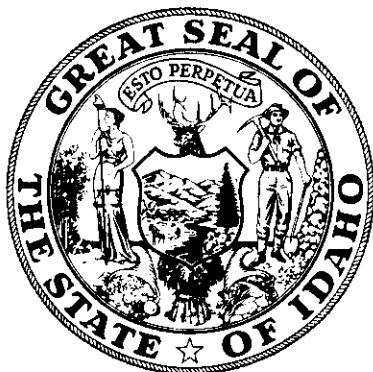

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

KOOTENAI COUNTY INTERGROUP OF
ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS, INC.

The undersigned persons, of legal age and residence of the County of Kootenai, State of Idaho, acting as incorporators of a non-profit corporation under the provisions of Chapter 3 of Title 30, Idaho Code, known as the "Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act," do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is KOOTENAI COUNTY INTERGROUP OF ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS, INC.

ARTICLE II.

This corporation is and shall forever be a non-profit corporation organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under the applicable sections of the Internal Revenue Code. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which has established its tax-exempt status under the applicable sections of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE III.

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual, unless otherwise dissolved in accordance with law.

ARTICLE IV.

The sole purpose of this corporation shall be to serve the suffering alcoholic and to offer such aid, support, and assistance as it is within its power to do so, and to conduct all of its affairs within the purview of the principles and traditions of Alcoholics Anonymous.

ARTICLE V.

The members of this corporation shall be persons elected to membership by Alcoholics Anonymous groups located within Kootenai County. There shall be no membership fees or dues assessed. The number of officers and directors and their duties shall be as established in the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VI.

The provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation shall be contained in the By-Laws, as they shall be duly adopted by the board of directors of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII.

The number of the first Board of Directors shall be not less than five (5) persons, which Board shall serve until by-laws are duly adopted and officers selected to serve in such capacities as may be established by the by-laws, and the Directors shall be thereafter in such number as from time to time shall be established by the by-laws.
