The undersigned, acting to incorporate a corporation under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

1. NAME: The name of the corporation is Hunter Heights Association, Inc.
2. NONPROFIT: This is a nonprofit corporation.
3. DURATION: The period of its duration is perpetual.
4. PURPOSES: The purpose for which is corporation is formed is to serve as the formal governing body as set forth in the Declaration of Protective Restrictions for the Hunter Heights Subdivision of Bannock County, Idaho and undertake such other purposes as are consistent with Idaho law and the Declaration of Protective Restrictions.
5. EXEMPT STATUS: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 4 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

6. MEMBERS AND VOTES: This Corporation will have members. Each owner of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 within Hunter Heights Subdivision, Bannock County, Idaho shall be a member and each member shall have one vote for each lot owned by that member. Only one vote per lot shall be allowed.

7. INTERNAL AFFAIRS: Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are such as may be provided in detail by the corporation's By-Laws and the Declaration of Protective Restrictions.

8. DISSOLUTION: In the event of dissolution, the corporation shall satisfy all valid obligations as required by law. Any assets remaining shall be distributed pursuant to Idaho Code to an entity described in section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or to its members or those persons whom the corporation holds itself out as benefitting or serving as set forth in Idaho Code section 30-3-113.

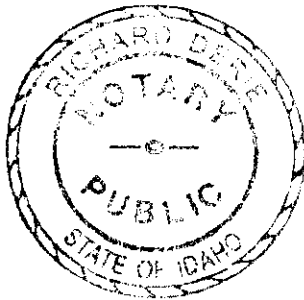
