

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

State of Idaho, :
County of Owyhee. :

We, the undersigned, being desirous of forming a corporation for the purposes hereinafter set forth under and in pursuance of the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify and declare as follows, to-wit:

First: That the said corporation shall be known by the name "SOUTH SINKER GOLD MINING COMPANY, LIMITED."

Second: That the purposes for which said corporation is formed shall be to carry on and conduct in said State the business of mining in, and extracting metals of gold and silver, and all other metals from that certain quartz mining claim known by the name "LUCKY FRIDAY", situate and recorded in French Mining District, in the County of Owyhee, and State of Idaho, and milling, reducing, or in any manner disposing of the same, and also the business to be conducted in said State, of prospecting for, buying, selling, or in any manner acquiring, or disposing of other lode or placer mining claims situate in said county, and extracting therefrom all metals they may contain, and to carry on generally the business of milling, smelting, or in any manner reducing ores, sands, or earth containing gold, silver, or other metals, and in buying, selling, acquiring, or disposing of the same.

Third: That the amount of the capital stock of said corporation shall be one million dollars, divided into one million shares of stock of the par value of one dollar each.

Fourth: That the principal place of business of said corporation shall be at the town of Silver City, in the County of Owyhee, in the State of Idaho.

Fifth: That the said corporation shall exist for a term of fifty years.

Sixth: That the number of directors who shall manage the concerns of said corporation for the first year shall be five, and the following are the names of said directors, to-wit:

Julius Isay, whose place of residence is Silver City, Owyhee County, Idaho.
