ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

EL-SHADDAI FELLOWSHIP--FULL GOSPEL, INC.

We, the undersigned, Donald E. Millican, LeRoy
Twitchell, John Toupin, Donald L. Millican, and David L. Boyd,
being residents of the State of Idaho, and citizens of the United
States, on this date form a nonprofit corporation under the laws
of the State of Idaho pursuant to Chapter 3 of Title 30 of the
Idaho Code and do hereby adopt the following Articles of
Incorporation:

I.

The name of this corporation is: E1-Shaddai Fellowship--Full Gospel, Inc.

II.

This corporation is formed exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes:

- (a) To promulgate and advance the Gospel, Teachings and Ministry of Jesus Christ. These purposes shall be accomplished by the establishment and maintenance of a place of worship, by the preaching and teaching of the Word of God as it is set forth in the Bible, which is the only infallible authoritative Word of God, by the distribution of Christian tracts and other types of Christian writings and by the promotion of the general welfare of the community, both spiritual and otherwise. The mission of said charitable corporation shall operate in the State of Idaho and throughout the world.
- (b) To effectuate the purposes of this corporation, it shall have the following powers in addition to all other powers as provided under the laws of the State of Idaho:
 - (1) To purchase, receive, take, acquire, hold,

(2) To receive property by devise or bequest, subject to the laws regulating the transfer of property by will, and to otherwise acquire and hold all property, real or personal, including shares of stock, bonds, and securities of other corporations.

- (3) To act as trustee under any trust incidental to the principal objects of the corporation, and to receive, hold, administer, and expend funds and property subject to such trust.
- (4) To convey, exchange, lease, mortgage, encumber, transfer upon trust, or otherwise dispose of all property, real or personal.
- (5) To borrow money, contract debts, and issue bonds, notes and debentures, and secure same.
- (6) To contract and be contracted with.
- (7) To do all acts necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs and attainment of the purposes of the corporation.
- (c) The foregoing provisions shall be construed as both purposes and powers, but no recitation, expression or declaration of specific, or special powers or purposes herein enumerated, shall be deemed to be exclusive, but it is hereby expressly declared that other lawful powers not inconsistent herewith are hereby included.
- (d) To do any and all things which a natural person might do which are necessary and desirable for the general purpose for which this corporation is organized, limited in every case, however, to those things which are within the meaning and purview of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, and in no case may any of the powers granted in this Article be deemed to include any powers which are contrary to the meaning and purview of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue

source; said funds to be applied for general charitable, religious, educational and benevolent purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

- (f) To license and ordain ministers of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
- (g) For any other lawful purpose, not contrary to any of the above.

III.

The address of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Idaho is: 515 2nd Ave. E., Jerome, Idaho, 83338. The initial registered agent is Donald E. Millican, 515 2nd Ave. E., Jerome, Idaho, 83338.

IV.

This corporation shall have members, the number and qualification of such shall be set forth in the By-Laws. The members shall appoint a Board of Directors of not less than five (5) nor more than fifteen (15) directors. The initial directors are as follows:

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall enure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to be paid reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any

- (a) A corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or
- (b) By a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

VI.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is located.
