This is to certify That we the undersigned have pursuant to the provisions of an act concerning Corporations passed and approved by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Idaho January Twelfth Eighteen Hundred and seventy five (Jan 12 1875) formed a Company under the name and title of ~~The~~ ^{First} Cooperative Mercantile Institution of Oakley. The general nature of the business to be transacted in General Merchandize, Milling and Manufacturing amount of Capital Stock Ten Thousand Dollars The Existence of this Company is to commence on the first day of January Eighteen hundred and Eighty Three and is to terminate on the first Day of January nineteen Hundred. The number of shares of its stock ^{shall be} 1000 at Ten Dollars per share. The number of Trustees to manage the concerns of said Company shall be six. The names of Trustees who shall manage the concerns of said Company for the first three months are Horton D. Haight, George Whittle, L. S. Grant, Arland Bates E. R. Dayley and E. H. Karlson. The principal place of business of this

Company is to be located at Oakley
Cassia County Idaho.
