KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That NANCY DONELSON, being over the age of twenty-one (21) years, and for the purposes of forming a corporation under the Washington Business Corporation Act, hereby certifies and adopts in triplicate the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be: COURTESY COMMUNICATIONS, INCORPORATED.

#### ARTICLE II.

The nature of the business and the purposes for which the corporation is formed are:

- (a) To acquire and operate a communication system which will engage in paging, telephone answering and other types of service, but not restricted exclusively to those methods of communication.
- (b) To sell, lease, or in any manner dispose of, whether for cash or on terms or by means of any credit device, any and all personal property, including but not limited to every type and kind of goods, wares, and merchandise owned by the corporation, or in which the corporation has any interest whatsoever.
- (c) To borrow money, incur indebtedness, or issue notes, bonds or debentures, or other evidences of debt and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, convey in trust, or otherwise, any and all property of the corporation, as security for the payment of any such indebtedness.
- (d) To purchase, acquire, lease or hold real property, or any interest or estate therein, and to let, demise, convey, assign or transfer any such interest therein as the corporation may deem necessary or convenient in connection with its business.
- (e) To purchase, acquire or deal in shares of its own capital to the extent allowed by the laws of the State of Washington.
- (f) To purchase or otherwise acquire, in whole or in part, business, good will, rights, franchises, licenses, permits, and property of every kind of any person, association or corporation, and to pay for the same in cash or in shares, bonds or other evidences of indebtedness of this corporation, and to hold, maintain and operate, or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the property so acquired, and to conduct, in any lawful manner, the whole or any part of any business so acquired, and to exercise all the powers necessary or convenient in and about the management of such business.

- (g) To own and hold stock in other corporations, to establish or assist in the establishment, organization or formation of other companies, firms or corporations; to own, hold, sell, negotiate, assign, exchange, transfer, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate and otherwise deal in and dispose of any shares of the capital stock or any voting trust certificates in respect of shares of capital stock, bonds, notes, debentures, mortgages, securities and other evidences of indebtedness issued or created by any other corporation.
- (h) To carry on any business whatsoever which this corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the foregoing purposes or otherwise, or which may promote the interest of this corporation or enhance the value of its property or business; to conduct its business in this state, or elsewhere within the United States or foreign countries, and to have and to exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Washington upon business corporations, as such laws are now in effect or may be at any time hereafter amended.

The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, and the purposes and powers stated in each clause shall be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms or provisions of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

#### ARTICLE III.

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

#### ARTICLE IV.

The registered office of this corporation shall be located at: 169 S. Stevens, Spokane, Washington, 99204.

The post office address of the registered office of the corporation shall be: Box 8466, Spokane, Washington, 99203.

The registered agent of the corporation shall be: NANCY DONELSON, whose address is 169 S. Stevens, Spokane, Washington, 99204.

#### ARTICLE V.

The amount of paid-in capital with which the corporation shall begin business is not less than \$1,000.00.

#### ARTICLE VI.

The authorized capital stock of the corporation shall be \$50,000.00, consisting of one class of 5,000 shares of common stock having no par value.

No transfer of stock by this corporation by sale, gift, or otherwise, and including transfers by operation of law, shall be made except as provided in the By-Laws of the corporation.

The management of this corporation shall be vested in the Board of Directors; the number of directors shall not be less than three (3), nor more than nine(9); and the number, qualifications, terms of office, manner of

election, time and place of meeting, and powers and duties of the directors shall be such as are prescribed by the By-Laws of the corporation.

# ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

#### COURTESY COMMUNICATIONS, INCORPORATED

Articles of Amendment of the Articles of Incorporation of Courtesy Communications, Incorporated, are herein executed by said Corporation, pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 23A.16.040 and 23A.16.050, as follows:

- 1. The name of the Corporation is "COURTESY COMMUNICATIONS, INCORPORATED".
- 2. The amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of said Corporation is as follows:

"ARTICLE VI. shall be amended to read as follows:

"The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is fifty thousand (50,000) common shares of the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share for an aggregate authorized capital of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00). Said shares shall consist of only one class and each of said shares shall have equal voting rights."

- 3. The date of the adoption of said amendment by the shareholders of the Corporation is May 2, 1979.
- 4. The number of shares outstanding of said Corporation is two thousand five hundred (2,500) shares, all of which are entitled to vote.
- 5. The number of shares voting for and against said amendment, respectively, were as follows:

- 6. The amendment provided for the exchange of issued and outstanding shares, one (1) share of no par value stock for one (1) share of One Dollar (\$1.00) par value stock.
