ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the

HERITAGE ALLIANCE CHURCH 5

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, citizens of the United States of America, and residents of the City of Twin Falls, County of Twin Falls, State of Idaho, all being members of the hereinbelow named religious society and officers thereof, have, and by these presents do, associate ourselves together as a religious body corporate and to that end, do adopt, declare, publish and certify the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Heritage Alliance Church of the Christian and Missionary Alliance, Inc.

ARTICLE II

This corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE III

The term of existence of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The said corporation shall exist as a corporate body in affiliation, cooperation, and connection with the Christian and Missionary Alliance of Nyack, New York, the parent society and a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York. Should this corporation cease to exist as a corporate body in affiliation, cooperation, or connection with the parent society, namely, the Christian and Missionary Alliance of Nyack, New York, and subject to its purposes, usages, doctrines and teachings, then all property, appurtenances, and effects at that time owned by this corporation shall inure to and become the property of the Rocky Mountain District of the Christian and Missionary Alliance, a Montana corporation, under whose jurisdiction said corporation is located.

ARTICLE V

The purposes for which this corporation is formed, are:

A. In conjunction with the Christian and Missionary Alliance of
New York, and the Doctrines and Teachings of The Christian and Missionary
Alliance, to establish and maintain a church and to provide a place of
public worship in the City of Twin Falls, county of
Twin Falls, State of Idaho; to establish, maintain and

conduct schools for the religious instruction of the young, and to further other religious and charitable work, and to that end to adopt a constitution and establish by-laws, and to make all rules and regulations deemed necessary and expedient for the management of its affairs, in accordance with law and not inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation. This corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof. In aid of the general purpose of the corporation it shall hold, sell, transfer, convey or encumber any property; real, personal, or mixed. In carrying out its purposes, said corporation shall receive, hold and disburse gifts, bequests, devises and other funds.

- B. To conduct and maintain services for divine worship and religious observance, in accordance with the customs of The Christian and Missionary Alliance.
- C. For all lawful, charitable, benevolent, religious, missionary and educational purposes consistent with these articles and churches generally.
- D. For all other powers and purposes which may lawfully inure to non-profit corporations under the provisions of the statutes of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE VI

This corporation is a church and the management of its affairs is to be vested in its members. The church has a church governing board similar to a Board of Directors which Board's authority may be limited by the membership pursuant to the by-laws.

ARTICLE VII

The internal affairs of the corporation shall be determined by its constitution and by-laws not inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE VIII
