CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of HOME LUMBER AND COAL COMPANY.

STATE OF KANSAS, SS. SEDGWICK COUNTY.

We, M. A. Houston, President, and M. L. Moore, Secretary of HOME LUMBER AND COAL COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Idaho, and whose registered office is 712 Idaho Street, Boise, Ada County, Idaho, do hereby certify that at a special meeting of the Board of Directors of said corporation held on the 2nd day of June, 1945, said board adopted a resolution setting forth the following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation and declared its advisability, to wit:

"BE IT RESOLVED by the board of directors that the charter of the Home Lumber and Coal Company be amended by adding to the purposes of said corporation the following:

"To buy, own or lease real estate or leasehold estate for the purpose of mining, drilling or operating for oil, gas or other minerals; to produce, buy, sell or deal in oil, gas and other minerals, and to do all things usual and necessary in the promotion of said business and business of like or similar kind."

That thereafter, pursuant to said resolution and in accordance with the by-laws and the laws of the State of Idaho, said directors called a meeting of stockholders for the consideration of said amendment, and thereafter, pursuant to said notice and in accordance with the statutes of the State of Idaho, on the 23rd day of June, 1945, said stockholders met and convened and considered said proposed amendment.

That at said meeting the stockholders entitled to vote did vote upon said amendment, and two judges, duly appointed for the purpose, conducted said vote, deciding upon the qualification of voters, and declared that more than two-thirds of voting stock-holders of the corporation had voted for the proposed amendment, and certified that the votes were 2000 common shares, par value \$100 per share, being all the shares of stock of said company, voted in favor of said amendment by a written vote duly signed, giving their consent thereto, and no shares against said amendment.

That said amendment was duly adopted in accordance with the provisions of section 29-145 Idaho Code Annotated.

That the capital of said corporation will not be reduced under or by reason of said amendment.
