
1. That said corporation hereby surrenders its authority to transact intra-state business in the State of Idaho;



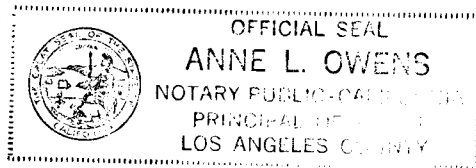
