AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF STATE ELECTRONIC CONTROLS COMPANY OF STATE (Formerly known as Electronic Controls (ECCO) Co. No. 2)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, the undersigned, president and secretary of Electronic Controls Co., an Idaho corporation, do for the purpose of amending the Articles of Incorporation of said corporation state as follows:

- 1. The name of this corporation is Electronic Controls Company.
- 2. The Articles of Incorporation shall be amended as follows:

III.

That paragraph IV as stated in the Articles of Incorporation dated December 28, 1979, and as the same were subsequently amended on April 20, 1984, be amended by deleting the same in its entirety and the following Paragraph IV be substituted therefore:

IV.

"The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of 50,000 shares of nonassessable, common stock without par value".

- 3. The Resolution of Proposed Amendment of the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the shareholders of this corporation by consent therefore in accordance with Idaho Code \$30-1-145 on the 9th day of April, 1988.
- 4. At the time of the execution of the consent by the shareholders of the corporation, there were 1,000 shares of common stock to which voting rights attached, 926 of which shares had been issued. There were no shares issued and outstanding of convertible preferred, cumulative, nonvoting no-par shares of stock. The number of shares which were voted in favor of the Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation were as follows:

James C. Thompson 796 votes in favor Raymond Woods 100 votes in favor Edward Zimmer 30 votes in favor

5. This Amendment does not effect a change in the amount of stated capital of the corporation.
