## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

KEN AND JOHN'S QUALITY AUTO SERVICE, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Incho Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for this corporation.

I.

The name of this Corporation shall be Ken and John's Quality Auto Service, Inc.

The period of existence and duration of the life of this corporation shall be perpetual.
