OPTIONAL ARTICLES

STATE OF DANGE STATES

Article 6: <u>Board of Directors.</u> All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of the corporation managed under the direction of, its board of directors, subject to any limitation set forth in a shareholder agreement authorized under section 30-1-732, Idaho Code. The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors shall be two (2), and the names and addresses of the persons to serve as director until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors are elected and qualified are:

Article 7: <u>Corporate purpose</u>. The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act. The primary purpose for which this corporation is organized is General Contracting.

Article 8: <u>Preemptive Rights.</u> The corporation elects to have preemptive rights.

Article 9: <u>Limitation of Liability.</u> No Director shall be liable to the corporation or its stockholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty except liability for: (i) the amount of a financial benefit received by a director to which his is not entitled; (ii) an intentional infliction of harm on the corporation or the shareholders; (iii) a violation of § 30-1-833, Idaho Code; or (iv) an intentional violation of criminal law.
