ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

KANIKSU SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNCIL, INC.

(A non-profit corporation)

The undersigned incorporators, desiring to form a non-profit corporation pursuant to the provisions of Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1: The name of the corporation is KANIKSU SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNCIL, INC.

ARTICLE 2: The corporation is organized as a non-profit corporation, not for pecuniary gain. It shall not have any power to issue certificates of stock or declare dividends, and no part of its income shall be distributed to its officer, directors or members.

ARTICLE 3: The period of duration for the KANIKSU SUBTANCE ABUSE COUNCIL, INC., shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE 4: The corporation is organized for the purpose of providing education, counseling, public awareness, and development of techniques to combat alcohol and other drugs use and/or dependency, through the operation of community awareness and counseling, for persons with alcohol and other related problems, to provide a source, referral or personnel to assist him carrying out Federal, State, County, City or other programs designed to

educate, counsel, heighten awareness or to develop techniques to combat alcohol and other drug abuse, to assist the judicial branch of government, if appropriate, in carrying out the mandates of judicially imposed probation or other programs for specifically identified persons or groups.

ARTICLE 5: Any person may become an associate nonvoting member of this corporation by agreeing to comply with and be bound by these Article of Incorporation and by the Bylaws, together with any amendments thereto as may be from time to time adopted.

ARTICLE 6: The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors, the qualifications for which shall be set forth in the corporation Bylaws. The board shall consist of seven (7) persons. Said board may delegate authority of conducting business to its various committees.

The Directors of the corporation shall be elected in the manner provided by the Bylaws; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, existing Directors only may elect successor Directors.
