OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being of full age and citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho,

And we hereby certify in writing:

I.

That the name of said corporation shall be C and C LEASING COMPANY.

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

- (a) To purchase, rent, manufacture, deal in, sell, operate, and let for hire, new and used motor vehicles, industrial, farm and other type tractors, agricultural machinery, tools, and implements of all kinds, including but not limited to combines, balers and windrowers and to purchase, rent, manufacture, deal in, sell, operate and let for hire personal property of all kinds.
- (b) To make, repair, sell, and otherwise deal in parts, supplies, and accessories connected with the use of any of the articles mentioned in subparagraph (a) immediately preceding; to store, clean, and repair any of the articles mentioned in subparagraph (a) hereof; and to do all other things incidental to the business of conducting a dealership for the sale of new and used items, or any of them mentioned in subparagraph (a) hereof; including the maintenance of garages, repair shops, or other businesses or facilities profitable in connection therewith.
- (c) To erect, purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire and to operate buildings or other facilities for the storing, repairing, displaying, and selling of any of the items mentioned in subparagraph (a) hereof; and parts

 and accessories therefor of every kind, nature, and description.

- (d) To deal in commercial paper, negotiable and non-negotiable instruments, documents of title, investment securities, accounts and contract rights, chattel paper, documents and instruments, general intangibles, goods, consumer goods, equipment, farm products, and inventory, and choses in action of all kinds, both as principal and as agent; also to buy and sell liens on real and personal property and to loan money and accept as surety therefor liens on and pledges of real and personal property; to act as agent or attorney for the transaction of any business or the management of the estates or the collection of rents, accounts, interest, dividends, notes, and bonds, securities for money, and demands of every kind and character; and to also act as agent or trustee for persons and corporations in any and all other matters which can be solicited, negotiated, operated, and carried on by an agent or trustee; also to act as agent or broker in securing loans effecting sales of real and personal property; to organize, finance, develop, and improve business firms, partnerships, and corpor ations.
- (e) To purchase, lease and otherwise acquire, hold, lease, sell, assign, transfer, pledge, exchange, mortgage, convey, and otherwise dispose of real property of every kind and description within and without the State of Idaho, and in any part of the world.
- (f) To act as insurance broker or agent for insurance companies in soliciting and receiving applications for insurance of all kinds and classes including but not limited to credit life insurance, accident and health insurance in connection with commercial paper and deferred balance contracts with respect to and covering any or all of the items mentioned in subparagraph (a) hereof; and in collecting and receipting for premiums on such insurance written by insurance companies; to do such other acts as are necessary or customary in such brokerage or agency and which may be delegated to it by insurance companies, and to receive commissions for its services as broker or agent.
 - (g) To borrow money and otherwise obtain credit for the account

 of said corporation and to issue debentures or other evidences of indebtedness therefor and to obligate the assets of the corporation as security for such indebtedness; to act as surety and guarantor in any and all types of engagements including the power to execute, endorse, and deliver contracts, and to guarantee the prompt and faithful performance and payment of debts, notes, agreements, contracts, and undertakings of any other person, firm, partnership, or corporation; and including also the power to act as an accommodation, co-maker or guarantor of obligations either as primary or secondary obligor.

- (h) To buy, sell, deal in, and operate any real or personal property, or to carry on any other business that may be of convenience or advantage in carrying on any of the activities authorized in the foregoing paragraphs.
- (i) The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers and it is hereby expressly provided that the enumeration herein of specific objects and powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers of this corporation and all the powers and, purposes hereinbefore enumerated shall be exercised, carried on; and enjoyed by this corporation within the State of Idaho and outside of the State of Idaho to such extent and in such manner as corporations organized under the General Corporation Laws of the State of Idaho may properly and legally exercise, carry on, and enjoy.

III.

That this corporation shall have perpetual existence.

IV.

That the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho shall be located in Rupert, in the County of Minidoka, and that the post office address of the registered office of said corporation shall be P. O. Box 96, Rupert, Idaho 83350.

That the authorized capital of said corporation shall consist of five hundred (500) shares of common stock of a par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each, making the total aggregate par value of the authorized
